Critique

Thank you to my stewards that kept me on the straight and narrow. Thank you to the exhibitors for your small but quality entry of dogs. Disappointing for me, and the Society, especially as it was the first time for our breeds CC allocation here today. The condition and turnout of your dogs was amazing and I really appreciated that fact. Movement today was not as good as I hoped for, which could have been due to the heat. I surprised myself on a few decisions, but judged the dog on the day.

Junior Dog - 1

1 Wade's Oldestone Take A Chance On Me - A Smart young man, with correct head proportions, dark eyes, good flew, and appealing expression. He possesses a moderate length of neck, leading into good angles in front. Correct amount of bone for his age and neat feet, level topline. I liked his coat colour and markings. He was rather unsettled today, and moved erratically around the ring. Still very young, but shows all round promise for the time to come.

Post Graduate - 2

1 Walpole's Gallybob Quantum Leap - Three year old of great substance good bone and excellent muscle tone, in very hard condition. He felt so good to go over. A well made all round short coupled dog, with a masculine head, a dark eye and good expression. He felt very firm in his front assembly, elbows tight, good tight feet, great spring of ribs, strength in his back and over his loins. Wide and powerful rear end, which was so well muscled, good width of thigh, level topline, and tailset, just carried a tad high. His movement was impressive with true footfalls going away and coming towards me. His coat was well turned out and of good colour. Owner needs to be aware of the dog on the move, and stance. Tempted to give him higher honours!

2 Martin's Laoirebay Steel Blue Ocean At Shannonstyle JW - Slightly longer cast in body than one, but has a good outline. He has a lovely head, with a soft expression, dark eyes, good earset and strong neck leading onto a level topline, and tailset. Possesses good all round bone, feet OK. His front needs to tighten somewhat. On the move today he was rather sloppy coming towards me, but in profile had a good extension of a long free driving stride. His coat/colour was in good condition, which is slightly ticked. Good presentation with great handling.

Limit Dog - 4 (1ab)

1 Collins Romaunt Blooming Grand At Forestpoint - I have watched this dog from a youngster, and I now feel he is coming into his prime at three years old. An impressive dog standing and does not disappoint once gone over. Full of great qualities which is what I was looking for on the day. He has a lovely flowing setter outline which is strong and powerful, super head with a good stop, good clean muzzle giving him a soft melting expression from his dark round eyes. Good even facial markings and ears set level with his eyes. He has a strong clean muscular neck, and well laid shoulders, he felt firm in front with good muscle tone and close-knit feet. Holds a firm topline, and has a great

spring of rib his back is well muscled and has good width, and his tail is well set. His coat and condition were superb, lovely feathering, gorgeous colour and markings. Wonderful presentation. He moved out with a long free stride, I loved him and was delighted to award him the Dog CC & BOB. Well done.

2 Ball & Harrison's Corranroo Commitment To Siorrudh JW - A different type to one, nice dog of good quality, strong and powerful to the eye on the stance. Good masculine head and stop, round dark eyes, clean muzzle good earset. Strong clean muscular neck, good front & chest. He holds a strong level topline standing, with spring in his ribs and wide powerful quarters. Great coat and colour which was well presented. Sadly he let himself down on the move, and was all over the place coming towards me; going, he drove off and went well with strong drive from the rear.

3 Barrett's Rustasha Golden Riviera.

Open Dog - 5 (1ab) Good class.

1 Barry's Sh Ch Rustasha Golden Rapper JW - One of my favourites! A five year old of great quality and lovely type. Superb outline, with an amazing silky coat of great quality. Well off for bone and substance throughout his body. I love his head which is very appealing in every way, with soft expressive dark eyes. His condition and turnout was again faultless. Very well presented, and I was tempted to give him top honours, but sadly he had a damaged tail, and I felt his mind was not on his job today. RCC.

2 Birch & West's Sh Ch Corranroo Camero At Hitides - Another dog of good type, different to the above, and very similar to my second in the Limit class being half brothers. Super masculine head, strong muscular neck, good angulation front and rear. Well balanced in body. Good bone and substance, neat feet strong backend. Great colour and conditioned coat. Moved out OK. I have done him well in the past, and he was unfortunate to meet one today.

3 Cuddy's Sh Ch Taxus Golden Prince In Balbriggan JW

1 Barry's Sh Ch Rustasha Rhapsody In Red ShCm - Superb veteran in anyone's book! Still a great moving dog, of good breed type, great in all departments: Wonderful colour, coat and condition, just flowed around the ring, and I loved his temperament, and outgoing nature. A dog to be very proud of. Well done.

2 Walpole's Lovenjoel Ice Cool

Post Graduate Bitch - 2

1 Hart's Ianbro Mystic Quartz Shines At Gilliegrae JW - I totally surprised myself on this decision but I could not get past her. A great little package, with a huge parcel of a happy real gem. I loved her pretty head, with a twinkle in her round expressive eye. All correct in her head neck and shoulders. Tight front, level topline, good backend, fair bone for her size, and super feet. Wonderful outline stood four square. Moved out with precision and a great 'look at me' attitude. I just loved her. Showed with style and confidence. Just wish there was more of her.

2 Ball & Harrisons Laoirebay She's Leaving Home to Siorrudh JW - Very pretty appealing headed bitch. Good confirmation, with bone to match. Super coat colour and condition. Great front, and shoulders well laid back; feet OK. Would prefer less weight and more substance. Needs more angulation and strength in her backend, still only a

youngster but just lacked the drive and presence of one today. She is a lovely girl, just needs you to get it all together.

Limit Bitch - 5 (1ab) Strong Challenging class of good bitches.

1 Bayne's Corranroo Consort - She won here on her presentation, coat, condition and movement. She was in lovely coat and feathering. She is coming to her best. Well balanced. Not a big girl, but loved her pretty sweet head, and expression of good proportions, hazel eyes, clean head and neck. Strong in front and tight overall. Good shoulders and spring of ribs, strong backend which she used well on the move. Coat, colour and condition were excellent. Well shown by handler. I was delighted to award her the R.CC.

2 Soper's Lovenjoel Belle Of The Ball - Close up to one a difficult decision to make. Just felt that she needs more feathering to complete the picture. Just loved her, she seems very familiar to me. Well presented, in good hard condition. Appealing head, strong in neck and shoulders, good tight fronted bitch. Good bone. Neat feet. Good spring of ribs, and strong back end. Lovely outline. Coat and condition great. Just needs more time to complete the picture. Liked her attitude. Very well presented and handled to perfection. She'd do anything for you! Moved well. Lovely bitch. Well done.

3 Walker's Zendarric It's A Kind Of Magic Within Wroxham JW

Open Bitch - 1

1 Hart's Gilliegrae Swift N' Chic - Her name suits her well. She won this class on her outstanding movement. Did not put a paw wrong, going away or coming towards me. A bigger bitch of good quality, loved her overall outline, which is strong and powerful throughout and suits the breed standard very well. Coat and condition very good, not a flashy bitch, but what you see is what you get. Probably not my type of head for a bitch but feminine without any coarseness. She has the power and strength in her front, body and rear end to allow her to move out on a long, free striding effortless gait. She has great strength in her overall body proportions, with the power to drive around the ring easily today. My pleasure to award her the BCC & Best Opposite Sex. Well done.
