I thoroughly enjoyed my day and thank you to all exhibitors who allowed me to judge their beautiful dogs, and I must say that the quality and condition of exhibits were excellent.

PUPPY DOG (1,0)

- 1st: Terne Des Coris Qalimero at Coolfin (Imp Bel) NAF TAF – Mrs M Knox & Miss T Jakins
Lovely young boy who looked like he was thoroughly enjoying his day. Very nice head with a lovely soft expression, good length of neck and well placed shoulders, nice angles both front and rear. Movement a little erratic but would expect nothing else from a puppy who was obviously enjoying himself albeit to the detriment of his handler. BP

POST GRADUATE DOG (2,0)

- 1st: Alanea Game Reserve with Danwish – Miss T Gardner
Very promising smart young man with good head proportions and nice expression. Good fore chest and well laid shoulders, good muscle tone throughout and strong hindquarters. Moved well with reach and drive.
2nd: Romaunt Bloomin Grand at Forestpoint – Mr P & Mrs L Collins
Another flashy young man with lovely head and expression. Nice front and well placed shoulders and good angulation front and rear. Well off for bone standing on tight feet. Moved well but didn't quite have the the drive of 1.

LIMIT DOG (3,0)

Smart boy with a lovely outline when stacked. Good head and nice expression, well placed shoulders with good spring of rib. Lovely front and strong rear quarters which he used to his advantage on the move. I'm sure it won't be long before this boy gains his title.
2nd: Roanjora Castelao JW ShCM – Mr R & Mrs D McDonald & Miss R McDonald
Lovely boy who I have judged before and didn't disappoint. Good shaped head and soft expression, well laid shoulders, good front and extremely well muscled and moved with purpose at one with his handler.
3rd: Corranroo Commitment to Siorrudh JW – Mr C Ball & Mrs J Harrison

OPEN DOG (2,0)

- 1st: Sh Ch Rustasha Golden Rapper JW – Mr B & Mrs S Barry
This boy has matured into a lovely example of the breed who is in his prime and his outline makes him impossible to overlook. Good head, neck and shoulders and lovely top line which he holds on the move. Ample forchest and good depth, moved from the rear with plenty of drive. RCC
- 2nd: Sh Ch Killary's Grand Venture with Vanders & Romaunt (Imp USA) JW – Mr J Barney & Mrs J Howatson
Another very nice young man with masculine head and good length of neck into well placed shoulders. Good angulation both front and rear, well bodied and moved out well just didn't look to have the maturity of 1

VETERAN DOG (5,0)

- 1st: Sh Ch & Ir Sh Ch Vanders Va Voom Avec Wroxham – Mrs E Walker
A mature gentleman I have judged before and so pleased with his performance today at the ripe old age of almost 10. Lovely head with a kind soft expression, good forechest and shoulder placement, well off for bone and standing on good feet. Excellent movement from the rear and showed that he can still own the ring. DCC/ BV/BOS.
- 2nd: Sh Ch Ballakinnish Malachi At Oldestone – Mr D & Mrs V Wade
Another lovely dog with good head and expression, lovely front and excellent shoulders. Level topline which he held on the move using strong hindquarters. Didn't seem to have the enthusiasm of 1 today.

Another nice youngster with a lot of positive attributes. Pretty head and good eye colour, good spring of rib and nice rear angles. Moved well.
