Critique

I really enjoyed my time with you at the Gundog Society of Wales Championship Show. I found some very good dogs to go over. As a Gundog All Rounder I kept remembering our mantra - "Fit for function fit for purpose" and found quite a few flat feet in the breed. A working dog is only as good as his feet, thin flat ones will be very painful in a short time. I note that I have mentioned this every time I have awarded CC's in the Breed!! I see that three of my top dogs were full brothers and sisters. All my top awards very much filled my interpretation of the standard.

PUPPY DOG (1-0)

- 1st: Oldestone Take A Chance On Me – Mr D & Mrs V Wade
10 months, pleasing masculine head, just right for age with good eye, square muzzle - clean neck, I would have liked a little more angulation in the forehead, ribs had good depth and length, could have had a little more spring, the topline, loin, tailset an carriage were good, well muscled rear end nice bone and feet, drove soundly from the rear, pinned in slightly in front.

JUNIOR DOG (3-0)

- 1st: Laoirebay Steel Blue Ocean At Shannonstyle – Mr S & Mrs A Martin
2nd: Spycyfire Secret Agent – Mr R & Mrs S Humphries

Two 13 month old youngsters with good balanced outlines, both had pleasing masculine heads, and clean necks set into well constructed forequarters. 1 had a better spring of rib, both had good depth and length of rib, loins were strong and toplines good, on the move I preferred firsts tail carriage. Rear ends were well constructed, both covering the ground well using good legs and tight feet with good

2 years of age, good balanced outline, excellent clear coat colours, pleasing in head, good clean neck, front angles could have a little more angulation, this was causing him to flick his front legs out, good through the ribs with spring depth and length, strong loin good topline and tailset and carriage, well made rear quarters with excellent turn of stifle and good second thigh, low hocks, well boned legs and good feet.

LIMIT DOG (5-0)

1st: Alanea Game Reserve With Danwish – Miss T Gardner

2 years old, won a good class on excellent movement and good construction. Gentle masculine head, good proportions throughout the head, set on clean neck set into well made forequarters, correct though the body with well muscled rear end and good low hocks, excellent bone and feet, a very sound mover in excellent coat of good pearly colour. Res Dog CC.

2nd: Corranroo Camero At Hitides – Mrs E Birch & Mrs C West

4 years old, very good balanced outline, excellent masculine head, set on clean neck, good lay of shoulder, angulation of first better in upper arm, made his front movement a little choppy, excellent ribs, strong loin, and well made rear end, moved out well on good legs and feet, in super coat.

OPEN DOG (2-0)

1st: Sh Ch Rustasha Golden Rapper JW – Mr B & Mrs S Barry

4 years old, very good dog, excellent balanced outline, he had pleasing masculine head, set on clean neck flowing into well made forequarters, ribs had spring depth and length, strong loin good topline and tailset and carriage, well angulated rear with good muscle to first and second thigh, low hocks, good bone, feet could be tighter. A really sound mover in. Excellent coat, with good pearly sheen. Dog CC and Reserve Best of Breed.

2nd: Courtdown One In A Million – Mrs L Ward

Three and a half years old, nice balanced outline, pleasing masculine head, well made fore and rear quarters soundly made through the ribs with spring depth and length, strong loin, good topline tailset and carriage, good turn of stifle, good bone, feet could be tighter, nice coat colour and furnishings. 1 had the edge on front movement.

VETERAN DOG (2-0)

1st: Lovenjoel Ice Cool – Mrs D Walpole Nearly 8 years, excellent overall balance, most pleasing masculine head with good proportions, well angulated front and rear quarters, good through the ribs with spring depth and length, strong loin good topline, well muscled rear end, in super coat with good furnishings a sound mover on well boned legs, feet could be tighter Best Veteran In Breed

2nd: Rustasha Rhapsody In Red – Mr B & Mrs S Barry
7 years old, good balanced outline, pleasing in head, good angles to front and rear quarters, a little finer through the ribs, not the spring of first, he had good depth and length of rib, strong loin good topline tailset and carriage, well turned stifle, good low hock, moved out well, first just had the edge.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (1-0)

1st: Dalcross Dancing Queen with Caispern – Mrs G O'Connor
8 months baby, a challenge to show, she had a good balanced outline, head just right for age, good neck set into well made forehead, excellent ribs with spring depth and length, well made loin, topline, tailset and carriage, well bent stifle and good low hocks, well boned legs and good feet, got the hang of moving out eventually, went soundly on the move, coat of good colour. Best Puppy in Breed.

PUPPY BITCH (1-0)

1st: Dalcross Dancing Queen with Caispern – Mrs G O'Connor

JUNIOR BITCH (4-2)

1st: Ianbro Corellian Calypso Tatsbro – Mrs O Henson
14 months, finer made but very correct excellent balanced outline, sweet head and expression, clean neck well made fore and rear quarters, ribs had spring depth and length, good through the loin, topline tailset and carriage, good turn of stifle, low hocks, moving soundly on good legs and feet, excellent coat colour

2nd: Ianbro Mystic Quartz Shines At Gilliegrae – Mr G & Mrs G Hart
14 months litter sister to above. Good overall, balanced, sweet head and expression, well made angles to front and rear, correct through the ribs, loin topline tailset and carriage, finer in bone than above and feet not so tight, one had the edge on movement.

NOVICE BITCH (1-0)

1st: Ianbro Corellian Calypso Tatsbro – Mrs O Henson

POST GRADUATE BITCH (2-1)

1st: Corranroo Cascade At Shannonstyle – Mr S & Mrs A Martin
Two and a half years, good balanced outline, loved her feminine head clean neck set into a well laid shoulder, could have a fraction more angle in the upper arm, makes her "toe-in" a little in front movement. Excellent through the ribs with spring depth and length strong loin topline and well set and carried tail. Carrying a little too much weight over the ribs, soundly made rear end from which she drove well on legs of good bone, feet could be a little tighter. In good coat of excellent colour.

LIMIT BITCH (6-2)

1st: Alanea Holly Fern At Charnborough – Mr T Sherratt & Mrs M Blackwell-Sherratt
2 years old, great outline, balanced and scopey, sweet head and expression, excellent neck set into well made forehead, good through the ribs with spring depth and length, loin and topline strong, good tailset and carriage, well turned stifle, super low hocks, a really sound mover on good legs and feet, coat of good colour and furnishings. Res Bitch CC.

2nd: Corranroo Consort – Mr G & Mrs J Bayne
2 years old, excellent outline very soundly made, sweet head and expression, good neck well made forequarters, correct through the ribs with spring depth and length, good loin topline tailset and carriage, well turned stifle and good low hocks, a sound mover on good legs and feet, not the coat today of first.

3rd: Oldestone Charlie's Angel – Mr D & Mrs V Wade
Res: Lovenjoel Sleeping Beauty – Mrs J Tait

OPEN BITCH (4-0)

1st: Sh Ch Alanea Summer Cottage – Mrs A Tattersall
5 years old, one I had not judged before, superb animal, she had balance, correct conformation, beautiful coat colour and furnishings, her movement was spot on and a joy to watch, a cracker, it made my day to be able to go over her. Bitch CC and Best of Breed. Both the Dog & Bitch Reserve CC's were full litter mates of a later mating

2nd: Sh Ch Ballakinnish Mischief Making Copperwhite JW – Mrs L Ward
Very pleasing balanced outline, gentle feminine head, nice angles to front and rear, well made through the body, she had good bone and feet and was a sound mover in pleasing coat.

3rd: Gilliegrae Swift N'Chic – Mr G & Mrs G Hart
Res: Roanjora Tsarine Txarina CW17 BWNL – Mr R & Mrs D McDonald & Miss R McDonald

VETERAN BITCH (2-0)

1st: Sh Ch Rustasha Rosa Kim – Mr B & Mrs S Barry
7 years old, she had a good balanced outline, sweet feminine head set on good neck let into well made forequarters, well made through the ribs and body, good turn of stifle and low hocks, moving out well on good legs feet could be tighter, a very sound mover, coat a little fluffy.

2nd: Ballakinnish Moulin Rouge – Mrs F Chapman
Nice outline, feminine head, well made through the body with good angles to front and rear, nice low hocks, good bone and feet. Eventually settled and moved soundly.
