I was delighted with my class winners and especially my top placings and all my decisions were final. Thanks also to my stewards for all their help and keeping my ring running smoothly.

Strong oval bone on good legs and feet, no exaggerations. Well bent stifle and deep in brisket. Presented, shown and handled in lovely fit, hard condition. He powered round the ring with effortless movement off short hocks with lashing tail. He looked an absolute picture and I had no hesitation in awarding him the Dog CC, Best Veteran and ultimately RBIS – only beaten by his daughter for BIS.
