Critique

Puppy Dog - 1

1 Tattersall's Carrick Shadow Dog At Alanea - CC and Best Puppy. Really top notch puppy, so good to go over. Liked his head, his occiput will no doubt gradually disappear as the top of his head is still finishing and skull is mostly nicely flat. Grand front, topline is level and firm in back. Excellent quarters and well set on tail slightly sloping from croup. Needs better feet, otherwise a real future star, Super rich colour too. Moving gracefully and long striding, a very efficient mover all round.

Post Graduate Dog - 1

1 Taylor's Laoirebay Monte Carlo - Looks rather unbalanced front and rear, maybe he is at his teenage stage. OK in head and pigment. Good neck, reasonable shoulder, but he does throw his front around moving. Deep enough in chest. Good backline, he needs more strength in rear, and not in the best of coats on the day.

Limit Dog - 2

1 Gardner's Alanea Game Reserve With Danwish - Res CC A nice gundog, good head, correct amount of stop, ears set nicely, fair front. well off for bone and tidy feet. Deep chest, level back, good behind, and he was very well muscled up. Back coat should be less ticked.

2 Taylor's Laoirebay Midnight Drifter - Badly behaved, but I must say he was enjoying himself! Coat too ticked, and he is a very tall dog, down on his pasterns. Muscle tone superb, and in good coat. Just insisted on being a nuisance on the move for his handler.

Open Dog - 2

1 Pilmer's Anisbrig Tobermory - Slightly limping in front on the day, but not by enough to dismiss him, but he looked miserable moving. A good dog to go over, beautiful coat and colour, with islands of rich red on a pearly white background. Good proportions of height to length, but down on his feet.

2 Knox and Jakins' Terne Des Coris Qalimero At Coolfin JW - In good body and muscle which I admired. Very short coupled, and too heavily marked. Fair mover, good head and muzzle. Lovely personality.

Junior Bitch - 1

1 O'Connor's Dalcross Dancing Queen With Caispern - Lovely freckled muzzle! Backskull good, OK in neck, and lay of shoulder. Enough bone for a female. Keeps her topline which is a fraction long cast. Throws herself in moving with great enthusiasm, but is not particularly true up or down. She went better in profile.

Post Graduate Bitch - 1

1 Hart's Ianbro Mystic Quartz Shines At Gilliegrae JW - One of our early imports. She is good for size, proportions of body, and is well ribbed back. Enough bend of stifles which are not exaggerated, and she has a well set tail. A bit short in foreface for her balance in head.

Limit Bitch - 1

1 Bayne's Corranroo Consort - Good quality bitch I liked a lot. Feminine head, flat skull, good neck and front, and she moves precisely coming towards. Good body, firm back, goes away a touch close in rear, well set and carried tail. She holds herself proudly when on a loose lead. Lovely coat and islands of rich colour.

Open Bitch - 4

1 Hart's Gilliegrae Swift N'chic - CC and BOB Three very good and typical Red/Whites, I was delighted to see. Winner could perhaps be a little more toned up, but she moves truly, and has some width about her moving. Ideal outline, firm topline, well boned, and excellent heart and lung room. Topped by a lovely head, and expressive eyes. Good colour and coat.

2 Tattersall's Killarys Class Act At Alanea - Res CC Looked a winner standing, but not moving out quite as smoothly as above. Also appealed for her head shape and lovely eyes. Her neck is elegant and well arched, nicely bodied up and she has the right amount of rear angulation. Nicely marked coat and in good nick throughout.

3 Tait's Sh Ch Lovenjoel Sleeping Beauty.

Veteran Bitch - 1

1 Mole and Knox's Dalriach Silver Tassie At Edincraw - In lovely condition throughout, and so attentive and looking for instructions from her handler! Good size and

*proportions, super bone and feet, nice over the croup, and she has a happy wagging tail.
A credit to her owner indeed.*
