### *Critique*

Many thanks to all of you that made the trip into the middle of Wales. Thankfully we didn't get the normal downpours of rain. I must say I really enjoyed judging the breed for the first time. It's a breed I've come to later on in my showing career and I'm so fond of the breed. Generally I thought the quality was good, but dogs are certainly more competitive which was evident in the open dog class. With so many quality dogs in it! I was surprised at a couple of exhibits lacking some depth of muzzle making them look a little snippy in head. Not a trait I associate with IRWS. It was good to see the BV go on and represent the breed in the best in show ring for BVIS.

#### MINOR PUPPY DOG (2-0)

1<sup>st</sup>: Oldestone Take A Chance On Me – Mr D & Mrs V Wade

A real melting head and expression. Such a lovely kind eye just typical of his father. Just 8 months and a raw baby. Plenty of bone and substance all through. A good rib and length of back. Level topline and good tail set and carriage. Good clear coat and colour. Needs to drop into himself at this point. Moved with a happy disposition.

#### PUPPY DOG (4-1)

- 1<sup>st</sup>: Terne Des Coris Qalimero at Coolfin (Imp Bel) NAF TAF – Mrs M Knox & Miss T Jakins  
This masculine dog needs to be gone over to appreciate his qualities. Lovely head and expression with a good dark eye well set and good ear setting. Good rib and depth of body with a good strong loin. Level topline and tail set. However, he's at that age of liking his tail a little too much at the moment on the move. Good oval bone and correct feet. Correct front into a good forehand and clean neck. Steady on the move both ways. Needs to drop into himself and mature. And I would like just a little more bend of stifle.
- 2<sup>nd</sup>: Laoirebay Steel Blue Ocean – Mr M & Mrs A Martin  
Another masculine boy with a pleasing head and expression. Oval bone. With a good spring of rib and depth of body, correct topline and well set on tail. Moved away well with good rear foot fall. Little wide in front coming towards you. Kept a level topline in profile movement.
- 3<sup>rd</sup>: Laoirebay Winter Promise – Ms F Griffin

#### JUNIOR DOG (2-0)

- 1<sup>st</sup>: Laoirebay Winter Promise – Ms F Griffin  
Moved well for handler presenting a balanced picture in profile. Pleasing head and expression. Good oval bone, good coat and condition. Dropped off a little too much at the croup hence its placing in the previous class.

#### POST GRADUATE DOG (2-1)

- 1<sup>st</sup>: Zendarric Heart Shaped Box With Vizsaset – Miss N Green  
A lovely free flowing mover, with his handler just keeping up. He covered the ground with ease. Good oval bone and feet. Clean neck and shoulders, with plenty of body. Good ribbing and depth of brisket. Well let down behind and bend of stifle, hence his rear drive on the move. Well set tail. Good masculine head and expression. Considered for the RCC but lacked the maturity to compete with the older boys.

#### LIMIT DOG (1-0)

- 1<sup>st</sup>: South Sides Space Oddity At Coolfin – Mrs M Knox  
It was obvious that this boy hasn't shown much and would have liked his coat in better condition. But an awful lot to like about him. Super head with a good strong muzzle which some lacked. Kind eye and correct ear set. With a pleasing expression. Good bone and feet. Well made forequarters with good lay of shoulder. Plenty of substance. Good spring of rib. Well let down to hock. Moved well enough but with a bit more experience a lot more could be made of this boy.

#### OPEN DOG (5-0)

By far the best class of the day, all these boys being typical of the breed.

- 1<sup>st</sup>: Taxus Golden Prince In Balbriggan JW – Mr J & Mrs S Cuddy  
This boy has really matured so well since I last judged him. He's matured and grown into himself. Masculine head and expression with a kind round eye. Well set ears. Clean arched neck into a well constructed forequarter. Good return of upper arm into a good lay of shoulder. Good depth of body and well sprung rib. Well made rear construction and this could be seen

in the movement powering round the ring. If I was to be slightly critical, I'd like a slightly shorter loin. His overall quality and breed type were deserving of the CC today. He moved effortlessly around the ring keeping a clean balanced outline. Good clear colour islands.

2<sup>nd</sup>: Sh Ch Ballakinnish Malachi At Oldestone – Mr D & Mrs V Wade

I was really taken by surprise by this boy today. I've never seen him move so well before, he just chewed up the ground. Congratulations to the runner. He has just one of the nicest masculine heads of an IRWS that I have seen. He's right at his prime at 7. Good bone and feet into a mature body and spring of rib and strong loin. Level topline with correct tail set and carriage. Plus, his tail never stopped wagging. Presentation was also to his advantage today. I would like a little more bend of stifle

#### VETERAN DOG (2-0)

1<sup>st</sup>: Sh Ch & Ir Sh Ch Vanders Va Voom Avec Wroxham – Mrs E Walker

Having judged both these dogs previously, a few years since it was good to go over them again. Today I preferred the make and shape and balance of the 1st. For 10 years old he still has a style about him of "look at me". He went really well for his runner on the day, driving off well. And keeping a balanced profile on the move. Masculine head with nothing exaggerated, nice shape eye with level ear set, creating that typical IRWS expression. Good hear proportions to the body. Good depth of body and spring of rib strong loin into a well-made rear with good short hocks. In a fuller coat today to 2nd. Would like a slightly better foot fall in front. He did the breed proud in the Veteran Group and then in Best Veteran in Show.

2<sup>nd</sup>: Sh Ch Rustasha Rhapsody In Red ShCM – Mr B & Mrs S Barry

Slightly different type of boy. Would like a little more masculinity all over. Lacking the fill in the middle of coat, Well marked and in good condition. Lovely forehand into a good front construction. With a good lay of shoulder into a level topline with a well-set tail and carriage that never stopped wagging. Good strong oval bone. I preferred 1st rear bend of stifle. Moved away well with drive.

#### MINOR PUPPY BITCH (1-0)

1<sup>st</sup>: Dalcross Dancing Queen With Caispern – Mrs G O'Connor

A pretty feminine bitch at just 6 months old. Very raw. She came together on the move once she'd relaxed into herself. Super colour and coat. Good topline with correct croup and tail set. Good bone and feet and straight front with pasterns sloping enough. Pretty head and expression, kind eye and correct set ear.

#### PUPPY BITCH (3-0)

1<sup>st</sup>: Ianbro Mystic Quartz Shines At Gilliegrae – Mr G & Mrs G Hart

A nice make and shape and well balanced. Would like a little more all over. Lovely feminine head and expression, soft expression. Into a well arched neck and good lay of shoulder. Good spring of rib and plenty of substance for her age. Good bone and feet with correct pastern. Good flow through her clean neck and shoulder into a level topline and correctly set tail. Good clean colour and well marked. The handler needed to relax, and she had to work hard to win the class, unnecessarily.

2<sup>nd</sup>: Gallybob Scarletina Bolete – Mrs S Walton

A different type, maturer and a better size, good front with good oval bone and feet. Well ribbed and good depth of body. Plenty of coat and clearly marked. Handler didn't get the best out of her on the move, lacked a little bit of oomph!

A pretty feminine bitch but would a little more of her all over. A good colour and coat condition. Good oval bone and nice feet. Moved out well keeping a good topline. Would like a little balance in the head, pretty eye with a kind setter expression.

### POST GRADUATE BITCH (3-0)

- 1<sup>st</sup>: Alanea Holly Fern At Charnborough – Mr T Sherratt & Mrs M Blackwell-Sherratt  
Really liked this bitch from when she walked into the ring. A lovely clean outline with a well-balanced body. Absolutely super forehand with a correct lay of shoulder. A well arched neck which flowed into a correct topline with correctly set tail and carriage around the ring. Well ribbed and good loin and depth of body all in balance. Well constructed rear-end which showed on the move and this was the difference for the CC in the end. A very feminine head and expression, nice kind eye and good ear set. I'd like to see her in a year with in full maturity when she's really grown into herself.
- 2<sup>nd</sup>: Oldestone Charlie's Angel – Mr D & Mrs V Wade  
Well balanced head, with good eye, and soft expression. Plenty of substance although. Good spring of rib and strong loin and correct depth of body. I'd like a little more bend in the stifle and hence a little more drive behind. The tail never stopped wagging
- 3<sup>rd</sup>: South Sides Rose Of Mooncoin At Coolfin – Mrs M Knox

### LIMIT BITCH (3-0)

- 1<sup>st</sup>: Zendarric It's A Kind Of Magic Within Wroxham – Mrs E Walker  
A very stylish bitch on the move and kept a well-balanced picture in profile. Clean arched neck and forehand with a good lay of shoulder. Good depth of body and spring of rib. Well bodied and presented in super condition. A correct topline into correct tail set and carriage on the move. Good length of leg and nice short hocks. Lost out on rear movement to the CC winner
- 2<sup>nd</sup>: Anisbrig Kilkerran – Mr B & Mrs S Pilmer  
Clean neck and shoulders into a good strong topline. Correct depth of body and spring of rib. I'd like to see her with a little more coat which was perfectly understandable after a litter. Another one that is very stylish on the move with a good foot fall. Correct front construction, good bone and feet.

This bitch really covers the ground with absolute ease. Feminine bitch presented to her advantage. Plenty of substance in her body with a good spring of rib and depth of body. Strong loin into a well-made rear with a good bend of stifle and short hock
- 2<sup>nd</sup>: Sh Ch Casafelice Cormo At Charnborough – Mr T Sherratt & Mrs M Blackwell-Sherratt  
She was not on best behaviour today. A naughty 10-year-old! Lovely outline make and shape. In excellent coat and condition for her age. Good bone and feet. She didn't have the drive of 1st around the ring.
