Puppy Dog (1.0)

1. Birch & West's Corranroo Camero at Hitides. A very good puppy. His young handler did well moving him. Needs to grow into himself but at 7 months he has plenty of time. Well off for bone and with a masculine head. His colour is particularly good. BP.

Junior Dog (2.0)

1. Wade's Caispern Roddy Owen at Oldestone. Very neatly built. Showed excellent angulation throughout. Feet are super. Well muscled and clearly in excellent condition. Kept a good top line on the move. RBD

2. Barry's Rustasha Golden Rapper. A bigger built dog but all in proportion. Has a lovely depth to his chest. His ribcage just needs to barrel out some more. Moved well but not the animation of 1.

Post Graduate Dog (3.0)

1. Barry's Rustasha Golden Rapper.
2. Wade's Oldestone Strut Ya Stuff. A masculine head with a soft but alert expression. Good stop and well proportioned head planes. Front assembly is good which highlights a lovely shoulder. He was a handful for his handler but movement was good.
3. Lipscombe's Countdown Finnians Rainbow.

Open Dog (3.0)

1. Green's Countdown Field of Dreams for Vizaset. Well constructed mature dog for his age with correct angulation. More red on him than I would wish but his overall build and movement won me over. BD.
2. Barry's Rustasha Rhapsody in Red. Presented a good outline. Another good head and kept his topline on the move. Would like muscle definition to be clearer for his rear quarters.

Post Graduate Bitch (1.0)

1. Wade's Oldestone Too Hot To Handle. A smaller built bitch with a lovely feminine expression. Light on coat which meant it was easy to see she was well put together! Kept her top line on the move. A bit unschooled.

Open Bitch (7.2)

1. Lyus & Lyus's Lovenjoel Christmas Spirit. My notes start 'Pretty as a picture' and so she was. Compactly constructed, but all in proportion. Nothing overstated just correctly put together. A good amount of red islands which were a gorgeous chestnut. Movement was positive with good reach and driving from rear. BB and BOB.
2. Humphries Sh.Ch. Spyefire Seven Steps JW. A bigger bitch. So well constructed, but today she was out of coat and did not move with the flowing movement I know she generally has. RBB
3. Barry's Shireoak Caramel Ice with Rustasha (Imp).
