**CRITIQUE**

We were late into the ring on a very hot day and I felt that both dogs and handlers were unable to give of their best when moving, having said that I was very pleased with the overall quality of the exhibits and I feel that the breed is progressing nicely with some super young dogs and bitches which augurs well for the future of the breed. I apologise to the exhibitors that I was unable to stay for photographs, being called to judge Kooikerhondjes in a ring the other side of the showground. Thanks go to my stewards for their efficiency and kindness.

**Puppy dog (1)**

Birch & West's Corranroo Camero at Hitides. Well grown 10 month old, very typy and with good angulation. His head is balanced with a correct earset and dark eye. Good spring of rib, good forechest and plenty of heart/lung room. Nice colouration with well distributed patches. Moved well in class but did his best to throw his chances in the challenge, nevertheless BP.

**Junior Dog (3)**

1. Wade's Caispern Roddy Owen at Oldestone, a very promising youngster. Well balanced dog with good shoulders and front assembly. Good strong hindquarters. Lovely head and expression and moved very well. Another with well distributed dark red patches on a clear coat. Could not quite compete with his father on this occasion but watch this space. RDCC.
2. Barry's Rustasha Golden Rapper, another typy dog, well muscled and angulated, sufficient bend of stifle, well sprung rib. Would prefer tighter feet.
3. Barney & Howatson's Killary Grand Venture with Vanders & Romaunt (Imp USA).

**Post Grad Dog (2)**

1. R. Golden Rapper.
2. Lipscombe's Courtdown Finian's Rainbow. Shorter coupled than winner and not the bend of stifle. Otherwise a very worthy dog with a balanced head, good shoulders and depth of chest, good tight feet.

**Limit Dog (2)**

1. Tattersall's Alanea Game Warden. Smaller dog than his rival in this class but everything in proportion although I would like a little more substance. Nice shoulder placement, good head balance and kind eye, moved well.
2. Burgess' Tymaran Huntsmater, taller, rangier dog, good bend of stifle and well balanced head although slightly light eye. There were glimpses of reasonable movement but needs more training.

**Open Dog (3)**

1. Wade's Sh.Ch. Ballakinnish Malachi at Oldestone. Standing four square this dog is hard to fault, so well balanced, strongly boned and well muscled, nicely crested neck into well laid shoulders. He had everything I was looking for on the day. Moved with drive DCC/BOB.
2. Barry's Rustasha Rhapsody in Red, smaller, lighter boned dog, would prefer a little more of him but he is proportionate and has a very attractive head, good earset and kind eye. Good topline but a little proud of his tail on the move.
3. McDonald & McDonald's Roanjora Pinotage.

**Veteran Dog (2)**

1. Lipscombe's Sh.Ch. Kellizlot River Legend Two very different dogs competing here, liked the winner for his substance, depth of chest and good forechest, Nice head properties, a little stuffy in neck.
2. Barry's Rustasha Red Hot Rhumba, smaller, lighter dog with better shoulders than the winner but movement all over the place today.

**Puppy Bitch (2)**

1. Callaghan's Corranroo Coco, litter sister to the puppy dog and in close contention. Very pretty and feminine, good shoulders and balanced angulation. Nicely laid shoulders, strong topline and moved well. Coat clear pearly white with well distributed patches but I would prefer them to be a darker red. Moved well.

2. Cairn's Dalriach Wildfire\*\* this young bitch clearly needs extensive ringcraft if she is to complete at this level, she has the correct white coat with red islands but her topline, tailset and movement let her down today.

#### Junior Bitch (1)

1. O'Connor's Caispern Looks Like Trouble, she was no trouble at all, pretty bitch having substance without coarseness. Lovely head, good shoulders and well sprung rib. Moved well when she got into her stride and kept topline on the move.

#### Post Grad Bitch (3:1 abs)

1. Peacock's Spiralwood Springtime. Liked both these bitches but winner slightly better over all, nicely put together with well laid shoulders and well sprung rib, good bone and strong topline with correct tailset. Moved well.

2. Soper's Caispern Winning Colours, very pretty b. with kind eye but level bite. Not quite the substance of 1 but well balanced fore and aft.

#### Limit Bitch (7:1 abs)

1. Barry's Rustasha Rosa Kim best mover in the class which gave her this award. Nicely bodied up with good rear angulation and sufficient bone Nice head but would prefer a little more depth to muzzle, good neck into fine withers and nice rear angulation. Not quite the finish of 2.

2. Bayne's Corranroo Cruz, beautifully presented but a little plain in head for me. Another with good neck and shoulders, straight front, good feet, moved well. Light red patches and light ear colour. 3. Peacock's Spiralwood Lady Love.

#### Open Bitch (4)

1. BCC. Tattersall's Sh.Ch. Alanea Summer Cottage, very close call between these two very good bitches although 1 had slightly better movement. She has won well and I can see why, very nicely put together, nicely balanced, good colour, sweet head and good depth of brisket, tight elbows, a little longer in back than

2) RBCC Davies' Zymore Christmas Rose, shorter coupled than winner and not quite such good feet but otherwise similar remarks apply.

#### Veteran Bitch. (1)

1. Barry's Sh.Ch. Shireoak Hurricane Ruby Rustasha (Imp) Lovely 10 yr old, moved well using her tail to advantage. Pretty head, kind eye. Well balanced body properties, good forechest and well sprung rib.
