VETERAN DOG (1)

1st Walker's SH CH / IR SH CH VANDERS VA VOOM AVEC WROXHAM

Stood alone today, but would hold his own in good company. Best of heads, with ample stop, kind eye and correct ear-set. Well laid shoulders, ample upper-arm and deep in chest. Plenty of bone, tight neat feet and moved with animation in true partnership with his handler and thoroughly enjoying himself. At 8 years old his coat and condition are a credit to his owner. A worthy Show Champion of the breed. Best Veteran

PUPPY DOG (4)

1st Ball & Harrison's CORRANROO COMMITMENT

A pleasing young dog with a lovely head and expression. Very striking in outline, good shoulders and front and adequate rear angulation. Loved his rich red colouring on pearl white background. Still a little loose on the move but no doubt will improve with age. BPD

2nd Walpole's GALLYBOB QUANTUM LEAP

A real baby at just six months. Pleasing in head with square muzzle. Shoulders well laid and well off for bone. Coat of good colour. At the moment he is very erratic in movement and was hard to assess.

JUNIOR DOG (3)

1st CORRANROO COMMITMENT (repeat)

2nd Wade's ROANJORA TEROLDEGO

A well made young dog. Pleasing head with plenty of stop, strong neck and shoulders well laid. Had good spring of rib and well developed hindquarters. Not as positive on the move as my first place. Well handled

POST-GRAD DOG (3)

1st McDonald's ROANJORA CASTELAO

Presented an excellent outline, correct head proportions with clean muzzle.

Strong muscular neck and well laid shoulders. Has good oval bone and the desired good colour and coat texture. Has effortless movement and very well handled.

2nd Ward's CORNADORE ARGYLE WITH COPPERWHITE

A young dog, with time on his side. Well off for bone with correct shoulders and front, clean over neck and good depth to brisket. Shown in excellent coat of good colour.

OPEN DOG (6)

1st Barry's RUSTASHA GOLDEN RAPPER

Masculine in head but without coarseness, pleasing dark eye. Best of fronts with well laid shoulders. Strong powerful hindquarters and stood on strong hocks. He is so balanced in outline when stacked. Coat of good colour with adequate feathering. Correct tailset, carried level on the move. Moved soundly with strong rear drive. An

excellent specimen of the breed. I believe that he has recently gained his title. BD and BOB and pleased to see he was shortlisted in a strong Group.

2nd Barney & Howatson's SH CH KILLARY'S GRAND VENTURE WITH VANDERS AND ROMAUNT JW. Another eye catching young dog with his best yet to come. Masculine head with domed skull and correct earset. Clean over neck flowing into well laid shoulders, deep in brisket with firm coupling. Moved with drive holding level topline well. Res BD

3rd Hart's REDMORE DIAMOND GEEZER MIT GILLIEGRAE

VETERAN BITCH (6)

1st Barry's Sh Ch Shireoak Hurricane Ruby Rustasha

This was an excellent class of veterans. My first place was a quality bitch so balanced throughout. Good head proportions and so feminine in expression. Clean neck and shoulders leading into straight front with excellent oval bone. She moved freely with drive, hard to believe she is eleven year olds, the only tell-tale sign would be the loss of the deep red in her coat, a credit to her owners. Res BB

2nd Jarvis's Shannonlee The Wood Lark

Close decision here, but just preferred the head of my first placed bitch which had better defined stop. Excellent shoulders and front assembly with ample upper arm. Good depth of chest, strong powerful hindquarters which she used to her advantage giving her sound movement.

3rd McDonald's Roanjora Chianti JW

PUPPY BITCH (2)

1st Barney's ROMAUNT AIN'T LIFE GRAND

I really fell for this confident young lady, really up for her turn in the ring.

Feminine throughout and has a pleasing head with adequate stop. Excellent front and shoulders. Adequate rear angulation and strong hocks. Moved soundly and very together for a youngster. I am sure she will do very well in the future. BP

2nd: Ward's Courtndown Fair Maid Of Devon, built on heavier lines than my first place. Pleasing in head with correct earset. Well developed in body with strong hindquarters. Just needs to settle more on the move.

POST-GRAD BITCH (4)

1st Farrow's ROANJORA FLEURIE

A pleasing young lady with feminine head of good proportions, correct earset. Presents a very balanced outline when stacked with correct angulation.

I would prefer a little more of her, but could not be denied her first place today. Moved with drive with correct tail carriage and handled well.

2nd Callaghan's CORRANROO COCO

Loved the head on this young bitch which had the desired correct proportions. Correct shoulders and front with deep brisket. Plenty of rear angulation well let down hocks. Moved well with good level topline and good tail carriage. In excellent coat and condition with pleasing markings.

3rd Chapman's BALLAKINNISH MOULIN ROUGE

OPEN BITCH (4)

1st Barry's RUSTASHA ROSA KIM

This was a quality class of bitches with close decisions. My first excelled in overall balance. I loved her head and expression, correct domed skull and clean cut muzzle She is strongly made throughout with plenty of substance, and well off for bone. Tail well set on and carried well. Powerful hindquarters which allowed her to move effortlessly around the ring. Presented in excellent coat condition with good feathering. BB

2nd Tong's RUSTASHA RAISOND'ETRE FOR KELLIZLOT

Another quality bitch bred on very similar lines as my winner. Another with good head proportions and adequate stop. She has the best of fronts, well placed shoulders and elbows tight in. Well angulated stifles and muscular hindquarters and shown in excellent coat and furnishings. Had free striding movement, my Res BB.

3rd Ward's Sh Ch BALLAKINNISH MISCHIEF MAKING COPPERWHITE JW
