



## DATA PROTECTION

The Irish Red and White Setter Club of Great Britain will comply with the data protection law. This says that the personal information we hold about you must be:

- Used lawfully and in a transparent way
- Collected only for purposes clearly explained to you and not used in any other way
- Accurate and up to date
- Kept securely and for as long as necessary

The data we store for each member/judge:

- Name
- Address
- Phone numbers
- Email address

We process your personal data for the following purposes:

- Provision of membership services including administration and transactional communications relating to membership
- Upholding the Club Rules and Code of Ethics
- to provide services relating to our events
- in compliance with Kennel Club Rules and Regulations
- to be able to contact you regarding future events
- to be able to provide you with Newsletters and other Club information
- Publication in the members Year Book or on the website (for committee members) unless otherwise notified
- Administration and transactional communications relating to judging appointments
- Publication on the Club's website Judging List and for appointments in the Show Schedules.

The details are stored on our membership database; there is limited access to it and your information will not be kept when you are no longer a member of IRWS Club of GB. We do not disclose your data to any other body.

We provide details of the IRWS Club of GB officers and Challenge Certificate winners at our Championship Show in accordance with the requirements in the Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Most of the information we hold is received direct from you and will be retained in accordance with statutory requirements, Kennel Club requirements and recommendations and the Club's retention policy which is available on request. You are not obliged to provide the personal data in question, however, if you do not provide the personal data, we will be unable to perform any contract we have with you for the provision of membership services, judging appointments or event services.

### Your Rights As A Data Subject

The General Data Protection Regulation provides the following rights:

- The right to request access to the personal data that we hold about you
- The right to request rectification of the personal data that we hold about you
- The right to request erasure of the personal data that we hold about you
- The right to request restriction of processing about you
- The right to object to processing
- The right to data portability
