## CRITIQUE

### PD (1)

1 Pilmer's Anisbrig Tobermoray. Very promising puppy, everything there as it should be at this stage of his development. Good size and of pleasing make and shape, balanced head with a good eye and expression. Excellent depth of chest for his age, good topline and tailset, well developed hindquarters, sound on the move, BP.

### JD (4)

1 Barney & Howatson's Killary's Grand Venture with Vanders and Romaunt (Imp USA). Stunning youngster who I am sure will make a mark in the breed. At 14 months there is still maturity and further development to come but he is so beautifully balanced and built on such clean and flowing lines that he can't be denied top honours at such a tender age. Excellent bone and substance, clean well balanced head, scores in neck and shoulders, good front, well sprung ribs, powerful quarters that he uses to advantage on the move, good bend of stifle, well let down hocks in excellent condition on the day. So sound, covering the ground on a free and easy stride, CC & BOB.

2 Wade's Caispern Roddy Owen at Oldestone. Another very promising young man who presents a clean and balanced outlook. Very typical throughout with good bone and substance for his age. Best of heads, well made front assembly standing on good legs and feet, well bodied with a good deep chest, strong loin and nicely rounded hindquarters. Pleasing tailset and carriage, moved out well both fore and aft but not quite as together as the winner on the day, Res.CC.

3 Farrin's Caispern Captain Christy.

### PG (5,1)

1 Tattersall's Alanea Game Warden. Dog of good size with lovely bone and substance throughout with that power and strength required but shows no sign of coarseness. Very typical in head with a good eye and expression, strong muscular neck set in well placed shoulders, pleasing body shape, firm topline that he keeps on the move, good width of quarters. Moved soundly with good reach and drive.

2 McDonald's Roanjora Castelao JW. Judged him as a puppy and liked him then and is another very promising young man with time on his side to develop into the finished article. Very typical throughout, good size, well balanced and of excellent make and shape. Best of heads, good front, lovely depth of chest with plenty of heartroom, well made hindquarters, sound on the move.

3 Mallinson's Courtdown Fame And Fortune.

### LD (1)

1 Bailey's Gallybob Rhett Butler. Pleasing sort of good shape and well made throughout. Balanced head with a kind eye and typical expression. Well sprung ribs, pleasing bend of stifle, moved well. Just carrying a little too much weight on the day that detracted from his overall appearance.

### OD (2)

1 Wade's Sh.Ch.Ballakinnish Malachi at Oldestone. Gave him a Best Dog award as a youngster and he has definitely fulfilled that early promise. Lovely type of good size with the required bone and substance to complete the picture. Very balanced throughout and built on clean flowing lines, no exaggeration anywhere here. Best of heads, pleasing front, good reach of neck, well laid back shoulders, firm body with good strength of loin. Strong powerful quarters, well let down hocks. Moved well once he settled. On the day not quite the presence of the two juniors when it came to the top honours.

### PB (4)

Four very pleasing sorts all at different stages of development on the day.

1 Callaghan's Corranroo Coco. Very feminine outlook but has the strength and substance to complete the picture. Excellent shape, very typical in head with a clean appearance and good depth of muzzle. Best of neck and shoulders, well sprung ribs for her age, pleasing width of hindquarters. Soundest of movers with good reach and drive.

2 Pilmer's Anisbrig Kilkerran. Another very promising puppy who is very well balanced throughout. Good size, make and shape. Pleasing head, eye and expression, firm topline, good tailset and carriage, well bent stifles. Once she got into her stride moved well. Not quite as forward in body as the winner on the day.

3 Valentine's Dalriach Whisper Tullamore.

1 Rowles Vanders Crimson Velvet. Lovely type of bitch of good size and built on clean and flowing lines. Balanced head with a very typical appearance. Pleasing front, good legs and feet, well developed body, good bend of stifle. Moved out well on a free and easy stride who really covered the ground.

2 Green's Shannonlee The Reed Bunting. Pleasing sort of overall good make and shape. Well off for bone and substance, balanced head with a good eye and expression. Good depth of chest, well sprung ribs, nicely rounded quarters, sound on the move. Just carrying a few pounds extra on the day.

3 Soper's Caispern Winning Colours.

LB (4,1)

1 Ward's Copperwhite Cinnamon. Very typey bitch of good size and has a very feminine outlook but still has the strong and powerful appearance the standard asks for. Pleasing head and eye, good reach of neck set in well placed shoulders, firm well muscled body, good width of hindquarters, well let down hocks. Moved soundly.

2 Shannonlee The Reed Bunting.

3 Caispern Winning Colours.

OB (4,1)

1 Tattersall's Alanea Summer Cottage. Have admired this bitch from the ringside and it was a pleasure to go over her. So beautifully made throughout with a very clean and balanced outlook. Loved her head, eye and expression, best of fronts, strong muscular neck and a good layback of shoulders. Excellent depth of chest, firm topline, correct tailset and carriage, best of quarters. Presented on the day in superb coat and condition, soundest of movers, CC. In the challenge felt she was not quite as positive as the dog on the day, but a very close decision between two top class exhibits.

2 Tubby's Sh.Ch.Taniswood Anything Goes. Another top class bitch who was unfortunate to meet the winner in such form on the day. Good size, very well balanced throughout, plenty of bone and substance but no mistaking her for a bitch. Very typical in head with a good eye and expression. Well made front assembly, strong firm body, good width of hindquarters, well bent stifles, sound positive mover, Res.CC.

3 Ward's Sh.Ch.Ballakinnish Mischief Making Copperwhite JW.
