## CRITIQUE

Thank you to the Officers and committee for giving me the opportunity to judge 'Our breed club show', and what an honour it was, super venue, super dogs and even the weather behaved right until it was time to take final pictures. Many thanks for my lovely gift of a Crystal Diamond!!. Thanks must also go to my two exceptional stewards Val Jarvis and Brian Pilmer who kept my ring running quickly and smoothly all day.

I found in today's entry a great variety in type, the breed seems to be getting long on the leg, long in body and in some cases lacking in angulation and drive from the rear, some heads ranged from the over strong to the weak of foreface and skull. Colour is excellent overall, temperaments were very good. To my surprise and dismay I did find a number of IRWS with pink under bellies, pink staining on legs front and rear and worst of all huge knots in their coats, unforgivable in my mind to have your dogs in this condition at anytime especially so when you are presenting them to be judged.

### Veteran Dog (7)

I love judging the Veteran classes, all of whom I have watched grow from puppy to adult, all a credit to their owners.

1<sup>st</sup> Humphries' Spyefire Priceless. 9 years old and can still show the youngsters a thing or two on the move. Just love the balanced head on this dog, enough foreface, gentle expression, kind dark eye, clean through neck and shoulder, deep chest, short coupled, well muscled, correct angulation front and rear, moved and handled to advantage (he was not with his usual handler today) in good coat and condition a dog to be proud of and unlucky not to gain his title. I did consider him for the Res.CC but felt the Open dog just had the edge in profile movement.

2<sup>nd</sup> Barry's Rustasha Red Hot Rhumba. Close up to 1<sup>st</sup>, lovely coat colour and condition, of lovely type, size and shape. Handsome dog with lots to like, unlucky to meet Priceless who was in top form on the day.

### Minor Puppy Dog (1)

1<sup>st</sup> Birch & West's Corranroo Camero at Hitides. Solid pup with a masculine head, good front assembly, good depth to chest, just starting to lose his angulation behind, coat of correct colour, moved well for a baby.

### Puppy Dog (2)

1<sup>st</sup> Pilmer's Anisbrig Tobermory. Loved this young pup, super outline, good head eye and expression, straight front, good forechest, smooth over shoulders, although the use of a chain lead did at times spoil the overall look. He is a lovely colour, well angulated front and rear, moving well for a youngster, coat in good clean condition. I had no hesitation in awarding him Best Puppy Dog and Best Puppy in Show. One for the future, Good Luck with him.

2<sup>nd</sup> Owen's Anisbrig Tamdhu. Litter brother to above, of good breed type, good colour, nice head, not the finish yet of his brother, moved ok.

### Junior Dog (7 - 2abs)

A good class of quality youngsters.

1<sup>st</sup> Barney & Howatson's Killary's Grand Venture With Vanders and Romaunt (IMP USA). Good looking lad with plenty of daylight beneath him, but, having said that he is balanced, he presents a clean outline stacked, soft gentle expression, enough stop and well shaped head, clean through neck and shoulders, well sprung ribs, lovely colour but would prefer just a little more red. Well angulated front and rear, beautiful side gait with lovely extension, but does on occasions tend to high step in front. Well presented in good coat and condition, was a bit of a fidget on the day.

2<sup>nd</sup> Wade's Caispern Roddy Owen At Oldestone. Liked this young dog too, so very close up to 1<sup>st</sup>. In good coat and condition, colour good, soft gentle expression, good head, good depth to chest, shorter coupled boy with lovely angles front and back, sound on the move. Another fidget.

#### Yearling Dog (7 – 2abs – 1wd)

1<sup>st</sup> Barney & Howatson's Killary's Grand Venture With Vanders and Romaunt. See above

2<sup>nd</sup> McDonald's Roanjora Castelao JW. I have admired this smart young dog since he was a pup and was not disappointed when I went over him. Lovely head, eye and gentle expression, in super coat and condition, good spring to rib, short coupled, well angulated rear, moved well, but I just preferred the 1<sup>st</sup> who was more collected on the move.

3<sup>rd</sup> Barry's Rustasha Golden Rapper

#### Novice Dog (4)

1<sup>st</sup> Barney & Howatson's Killary's Grand Venture With Vanders and Romaunt. See Junior.

2<sup>nd</sup> Hart's Redmore Diamond Geezer Mit Gilliegrae. Thought this young dog looked a picture standing today, shame he let himself down on the move. Masculine head with a good foreface and enough stop, good front that needs to tighten, good depth and spring to rib, short coupled, good behind with enough angulation. Coat, colour and condition all good. Should continue to do well.

3<sup>rd</sup> Farrin's Caispern Captain Christy

#### Graduate Dog (4)

1<sup>st</sup> Mawhinney's Paralexis Jovial Jasper. Apart from ears and feet this dog was totally untrimmed, but what a lovely dog there was under all that coat, strong head, but with a gentle expression, good forechest, deep through the ribs, well angulated front and rear, coat in good condition, needs help with presentation, on the move he just came alive, so very sound, free and easy mover.

2<sup>nd</sup> Mallinson's Courtdown Fame And Fortune. Nice boy of lovely colour, soft gentle expression, sound in all departments, tends to straighten in stifle at times when stacked, could have moved with more purpose.

3<sup>rd</sup> Barry's Rustasha Golden Rapper

#### Post Graduate Dog (7 – 2abs)

1<sup>st</sup> Lipscombe's Courtdown Finnians Rainbow. My surprise of the day!! This young dog was just what I was looking for, standing he presented a clean well balanced nose to tail outline, masculine and balanced head with a soft dark eye, clean through neck and shoulder, good forechest, deep through the ribs, short coupled, correct angulation fore and aft, well muscled and sound on the move both coming and going. Coat of correct colour and in super condition. It was my pleasure to award him his 1<sup>st</sup> CC much to the delight of his owner/handler. I hope his other 2 will follow soon. In the challenge for Best in Show I felt both he and his handler were a little overawed and after a long wait he was rather unsettled.

#### Limit Dog (4 – 2abs)

1<sup>st</sup> Green's Courtdown Field Of Dreams For Vizaset. Nice boy of lovely colour, liked his head and expression, good front and well ribbed, sound and well muscled behind, just felt he could have given me more on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> Baron's Shannonlee The Ptarmigan. Loved the soft and gentle expression on this boy, in the past he's made his handler work very hard, but today he was on his best behaviour. Well off for bone, good front, if a little untidy sometimes on the move, good spring of rib, well angulated behind, carrying a little too much weight today which affected his movement.

#### Open Dog (6)

1<sup>st</sup> Wade's Sh.Ch. Ballakinnish Malachi At Oldestone. A well known dog I judged as a youngster and did him well then. He presents a well balanced, correct outline when stood, I like his head and gentle expression but find him a tad deep in stop. Well angulated front and rear, deep chested and short coupled, well muscled and although he is very sound on the move felt he lacked the drive I was looking for. Coat and colour good but could have been better presented. Reserve CC..

2<sup>nd</sup> Barry's Rustasha Rhapsody In Red. Beautiful coat, colour and presentation on this dog and all others from this kennel. Lovely expression, eye colour good, would like him slightly more masculine in head. Good straight front, deep chest, short coupled, well angulated fore and aft, well muscled, moved well, but would like to see him drive more from the rear.

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Walpole's Lovenjoal Ice Cool

#### Veteran Bitch (6 – 2abs)

A lovely class of Veteran girls, all have given so much to the breed, and they show how well this breed goes from strength to strength well into old age.

1<sup>st</sup> Barry's Sh.Ch. Shireoak Hurricane Ruby Rustasha (IMP CAN). Pretty girl, almost looks like she is smiling at you, just the size I like in a bitch, good head eye and soft gentle expression, good colour and in excellent condition, lovely spring to rib, short coupled, correct angulation front and rear, moved soundly with a lashing tail. Just preferred the overall balanced outlook of the Veteran dog for BVIS.

2<sup>nd</sup> McDonald's Sh.Ch. Courtdown Summerbreeze Over Roanjora ShCM. One I have done well for in the past, and I have not changed my high opinion of her, but felt she was a little hesitant in hind movement today. Beautiful head eye and expression, good front, lovely spring to rib, good angulation front and rear, lovely colour and in excellent condition.

3<sup>rd</sup> Humphries' Laoirebay All That Jazz Among Spye fire JW

#### Minor Puppy Bitch (1)

1<sup>st</sup> Callaghan's Corranroo Coco. Nice little girl of good colour, would like more depth to muzzle, good length to body, she is at the age where IRWS lose their angulation front and rear, but all this should come back as she matures, moved well.

#### Puppy Bitch (3)

1<sup>st</sup> Pilmer's Anisbrig Kilkerran. Litter sister to my eventual BPIS, lovely pup, she presents a very nice outline, enough foreface though a little lacking in stop at the moment, lovely colour, good body shape for a youngster, well angulated both ends, moved well, plenty of time for her to completely get her act together, just fell in love with her brother, who was so much more balanced and collected on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> Callaghan's Corranroo Coco

3<sup>rd</sup> Mallinson's Anisbrig Ailsa Bay

#### Junior Bitch (4 – 2abs)

1<sup>st</sup> Henderson's Temynloah Zoe. Pretty elegant bitch of good breed type, lovely expression, good neck to shoulder, good spring of rib, well angulated front and rear, moved well, but could put a little more effort in.

2<sup>nd</sup> Hart's Gilliegrae Swift N'Chic. Nice bitch, good head but a tad strong for me, gentle expression, good spring to rib, lovely colour, well angulated front, but, would like a little more angulation to rear, moved well when settled.

1<sup>st</sup> Hart's Gilliegrae Swift N'Chic

#### Novice (3 – 2abs)

1<sup>st</sup> Hart's Gilliegrae Swift N'Chic

#### Graduate Bitch (5 – 3abs)

1<sup>st</sup> Chapman's Ballakinnish Moulin Rouge. A good honest bitch with no glaring faults, pretty head, good expression, find her a touch long in loin, well angulated front and rear, colour ok, moved ok.

2<sup>nd</sup> Mole's Dalriach Silver Tassie. I do like this bitch, lovely head eye and expression, lovely colour, well sprung ribs, good front, would like more bend of stifle, moved and stacked well when she was not scenting for birds. Owner could get more from this bitch by learning to stack her both ways so she can stand with her lovely nose to the winds.

#### Post Graduate Bitch (6)

1<sup>st</sup> Rowles' Vanders Crimson Velvet. What a pretty girl she is developing into, lovely head eye and expression, clean through neck and shoulders, good front, well sprung ribs, lovely bend of stifle, heavy red but this does not take away the fact that she is a quality bitch throughout. Moved well but thought she was carrying a touch too much weight on the day.

2<sup>nd</sup> Tong's Rustahsa Raison D'Étre For Kellizlot. Smaller more compact bitch of good breed type, pretty head eye and expression, good angulation front and rear, short coupled, moved out well, colour good and coat in good condition.

3<sup>rd</sup> Chapman's Ballakinnis Moulin Rouge

Limit Bitch (6 – 1abs)

Litter sisters headed this class.

1<sup>st</sup> Hawkin's Corranroo Carousel Over Aislingwood. Bigger bitch than I would normally go for, but, I just kept coming back to her. She is very pretty, with lovely head eye and expression, well angulated front and rear, clean over the shoulders and with a good spring of rib, in lovely coat and condition, moved so very well on the day. I was pleased to award her the Reserve CC and Res. Best in Show.

2<sup>nd</sup> Bayne's Corranroo Cruz. Lovely bitch presented in immaculate condition, pretty head eye and expression, good front but would like a better lay of shoulder, well sprung ribs, short coupled, good bend of stifle, lovely colour, moved well but not with the rear drive of her sister,

3<sup>rd</sup> Barry's Rustasha Rosa Kim

Open Bitch (10 – 4abs)

WOW!! What a class, I could have happily taken anyone of the first three bitches home with me.

1<sup>st</sup> Tattersall's Sh.Ch. Alanea Summer Cottage. A stunning bitch from any angle and one I have been waiting to get my hands on. Perfect size for me, with a lovely 'melt you' expression, good foreface, dark eye, clean through neck and shoulders, lovely spring to rib, short coupled, super angulation front and rear, short from hock to heel, lovely colour and in super coat and condition. Moved so very well on the day, she was everything I had hoped she would be, just loved her and it was with great pleasure that I awarded this fabulous bitch the CC and Best in Show. Wish she would come and live with me.

2<sup>nd</sup> Humphries' Sh.Ch. Spyefire Seven Steps JW. Another stunning bitch, so very pretty with a super head eye and expression, she is so clean neck to shoulder, lovely spring of rib, short coupled, another with super angulation front and rear, moved out beautifully on the day, just love her, but, she was resplendent in her underwear, such a shame, another I had been waiting to get my hands on and was in no way disappointed with what I found.
