Thank you to the Committee and exhibitors for giving me a lovely day judging your beautiful breed. The quality of dogs was a joy and I found myself with some hard decisions. Feet were my main concern as there were a number that appear flat and open with long nails, as a dog expected to run on moorland they do need to have good feet, but that apart the condition of all the exhibits was extremely high.

Dogs

Veteran (6, 2 abs)

1st Walkers SH/IrSHCH Vanders Va Voom Avec Wroxham. What a splendid example of the breed, his head is fully of quality, pleasing muzzle, defined stop, clear correctly shaped eye and well set ear. Strong neck leading to laid back shoulders, good return of upperarm and width of chest. His flowing topline led to an excellent rear assembly with firm second thigh

muscling, good bone and nicely shaped feet. Lovely to watch on the move, a real showman.
BD BIS BVIS

2nd Humphries Speyfire Priceless. Another handsome dog with a strong outline and showing the desired make and shape of the breed. Gentle head with good stop and an eye showing the wisdom of his years. Firm neck, well set shoulder, deep rib, good coupling leading to broad stifles. Feet not as tight as 1st but showed a good stride around the ring.

3rd Lipscombes SHCH Kellizlot River Legend

Puppy (3, 1 abs)

1st Cuddys Taxus Golden Prince in Balbriggan. Much more together than 2nd still gave his handler a lot of work when moving but settled enough for me to see what he is capable of. Very much a baby in head, good reach of neck and pleasing angulation, oval bone and clear red islands. Decent rear end showing lots of promise

2nd Wards Countdown One in a Million. Pleasing in head with parallel lines, correct stop and warm brown eye. A little unbalanced in outline at the moment, good depth of body and well muscled quarters, another who needs to put his mind to moving.

Junior (3)

1st Birch & Wests Corranroo Camero at Hitides. Mature 17 month dog with a masculine head, lovely shaped eye of good colour, slightly domed backskull with nicely set ear. Balanced angulation, deep well sprung rib, correct bone and tight feet. Best mover here showing good reach.

Yearling (3)

1st Barney & Howartsons SHCH Killary's Grand Venture With Vanders and Romaunt JW (imp USA) Quality, eye catching young dog who fulfils his promise on the move. Well up to size but all in proportion, would like to see more red in the picture. Plenty of work in his head, soft expressive eye, parallel planes and well set ear. Clean neck and shoulder flowing smoothly into a strong topline, plenty of rib, firm coupling and strong muscled rear. Excellent feet and oval bone. He had good drive and true footfall. RBD

2nd Barretts Rushtasha Goldern Riviera. Carrying a touch too much weight which spoilt his outline. Good length to foreface, bright alert expression, correctly set ear. Laid back shoulder, broad chest, deep in body, firm in coupling. A little unbalanced on the move until he settled.

3rd Rockwells Bodhidharma The Sorcerer

Graduate (1)

1st Wards Countdown One in a Million. Much more settled here, just needs to get it together on the move.

Postgraduate (2)

1st Barretts Rushtasha Goldern Riviera

2nd Harts Redmore Diamond Geezer mit Gilliegrae. Still a bit raw and had his mind on other things today. Not as balanced in head as 1st but had a kind expression and well shaped eye. Laid back shoulder with good return of upperarm, enough depth and spring of rib, broad muscled rear. Clean bone and feet, a bit erratic moving but his side gait looked good.

Limit (2)

1st Barrys Rustasha Golden Rapper JW. Another good sized dog, pleasing eye, nicely shaped backskull and well set ear. Firm neck, laid back shoulder, very deep in rib, correct oval bone, strong rear showing drive.

2nd Lambs Casafelice Plezzana. Preferred this boy's head but not as positive in front action as 1st. Typey outline, head showed parallel planes, gentle expression, kind eye. Clean through neck and shoulder with balanced angulation front and rear. Firm topline, smooth lines from head to tail, correct bone and feet.

Open (5, 1 abs)

1st Lambs SHCH/IrSHCH Casafeliece Montdale JW. Classic looking dog. Well made head with kind expression balanced proportions and correct backskull. Presented a lovely outline with plenty of forechest and good angulations. Deep through the body with rich red islands of colour, strong topline. Moved out well showing good reach

2nd Lipscombes SHCH Courtdown Finnians Rainbow Not as balanced in proportions as 1st being taller and shorter. Masculine head with good length of foreface and width to backskull. Flowed from neck through laidback shoulder, deep rib, firm coupling and broad thighs. Moved true but not quite the drive of my winner.

3rd Barrys Rustasha Rhapsody in Red

Bitches

Veteran (6,1 abs)

1st Bartons Tanisword Summer Rose with Bencorragh What a beauty, so sound in construction, just loved her make and shape. Very pretty head with lots of work in it and a melting expression. Excellent front, good spring of rib, firm coupling and broad well muscled rear. She looked good on the move from any angle and pushed the dog hard but just edged out by his sheer joie de vivre so had to settle for BB RBIS RBVIS

2nd Wards Copperwhite Cinnamon. Smaller bitch but pleasantly put together, soft expression, nicely placed ear, strong neck, laid back shoulder, good depth of body, not quite the width of thigh as 1st. Showed good footfall when moving.

3rd Barrys SHCH Shireoak Hurricane Ruby Rustasha (imp Can)

Puppy (1)

1st McDonalds Roanjora Montepulciano. Cheeky 8 month baby, excellent pigmentation, bright eye, feminine head which should mature on, clean neck, well set shoulders, firm topline kept true while moving. Vey together on the move showing drive from muscled rear. BPIS

Junior (1)

1st McDonalds Roanjora Montepulciano

Graduate (1)

1st Farrow's Roanjora Fleurie Nice sized bitch, good depth to muzzle and parallel planes. Balanced angulation front and rear, excellent spring of rib, shown in hard condition. A little unsettled moving but managed to get into her stride.

Limit (4)

1st Tongs Rustasha Raison D'Étre for Kellizlot. Honest bitch with a firm outline, good depth and length of muzzle with balanced proportions throughout the head. Clean neck, laidback shoulder, good return of upperarm, deep in rib, broad well muscled thighs giving plenty of drive.

2nd Chapmans Ballakinnish Moulin Rouge. Feminine head with well shaped eye, not as balanced in proportion but good backskull and earset. Strong front assembly, well sprung rib, slightly straighter in rear but good muscling. Showed good profile movement.

3rd Hawkins Corranroo Carousel over Aislingwood

Open (5)

A cracking class of quality bitches who could change places on another day, apologies for keeping you standing so long it was a difficult choice.

1st Blackmores SHCH Courtdown Beautiful Dancer Such a charming bitch with a delightful head, soft well shaped eye and plenty of work in the skull. Flowing neck, smooth laidback shoulder, excelled in front. Deep body with plenty of rib under a strong topline, broad firmly muscled stifles, correct bone and tight feet. Showed lots of drive on the move, just preferred the tailset of the veteran in the challenge RBB.

2nd Humphries SHCH Speyfire Seven Steps JW Another beautiful bitch, lighter framed than 1st but all in balance and nicely put together. Classic head with a gentle expression and well set ear. Presented a picture on the stand with correct angulation front and rear, firm topline over a good spring of rib, lovely feet. Great extension on the move, just not as firm in muscle as 1st.

3rd Barrys Rustasha Rosa Kim
