### **CRITIQUE**

Thanks to all exhibitors for bringing their lovely dogs, and for their sporting acceptance of my decisions. There was some very promising young stock on display and that must bode well for the future of the breed, however, it's unique shape and style must not be allowed to start blending in with that of the more refined Irish Setter. All four Setter Breeds are completely different and the 'one size fits all' approach adopted by some judges will serve none of them well. The Setters are slow maturing breeds and should be at their best later in life, this was most pleasingly evident today and I make no apology for finding my best of each sex in the Veteran Classes. Grey hairs do not change a good dog.

### **Veteran Dog. (1)**

Walker, Sh Ch/Ir Ch Vandera Va Voom avec Wroxham, here in the very first class came the star of the day, a beautiful specimen, great ribs, correct outline, level topline, well made throughout, athletic and sturdy, nicely marked, in excellent condition for his 8 years. Pleasing head with correct planes and expression, strong neck, sound driving and free flowing movement from firm muscular quarters is a lesson to all, beautifully presented too. BD and BIS.

### **Puppy Dog (5)**

1. Jones, Alanea Royal Reward of Berryessa, 11 months, athletically made with straight front and neat feet, mature and well marked, moved well with animation, has good angulation fore and aft, and pleasing outline, but owner is inclined to stand him too far over himself, which can be misleading. Consequently, one needs patience to fully appreciate him. Pleasing length of neck and very attractive head and expression. Best Dog Puppy.

2. Harrison, Corranroo Commitment, 10 months, mature and well made with correct outline, nicely marked, pleasing head and expression, at first sight when standing, thought he could possibly be my winner, but unfortunately 'feeling' his right foreleg on the move and had to pay the price.

3. Rowles, Zendarric Thunderstruck. 7 months.

### **Junior Dog (1)**

1. Wade, Roanjora Teroldego, 15 months, very well made. Masculine head and expression, pleasing outline, great strength to neck, can move Ok when he decides to, not exactly happy on the surface here, would prefer a little more angulation at the rear but that may come with maturity. Well marked. I have no doubt he will have a future.

### **Yearling Dog & Graduate Dog. (1, 1)**

1. Cuddy, Taxus Golden Prince, 16 months, great marking and colour, moved soundly with animation, pleasing quality specimen of the breed, well presented, just a little loose in front. But he is still young yet and will mature on and this may change.

### **Post Graduate Dog (3, 2)**

1. Pilmer, Anisbrig Tobermory, very well presented 2 yr old, great rib and body, moved very soundly with drive, pleasing headpiece, straight front and good topline and tailset, feet could be neater.

2. Taylor, Laoirebay Midnight Drifter, can move very well when he settles, straight front, attractive head, far stronger overall than 1, will thus need more time to mature into himself and learn what is expected of him.

### **Limit Dog (3, 2)**

1. Hart, Redmore Diamond Geezer Mit Gilligrae, VERY close decision between these two, this one has good head and expression, well ribbed up, moved with drive, neatly presented, just preferred his rear angulation.

2. Lorenzi, Vistador Bohemian, well marked with lovely head and expression, preferred him in front and he has a good outline, well presented in hard condition, moved well.

### **Open Dog (2)**

1. Lorenzi, Spyefire May Spring Rainbow, 6 yrs, well marked in great condition, neat feet, excellent ribcage and good angulation fore and aft, masculine head and athletic in build, Moved OK, Res BD.

2. Walpole, Lovenjoel Ice Cool, love this boy's head, such a melting expression, great skeleton and outline, just wish he had a tad more length to neck and moved with a little more animation. Nevertheless, his owner should be proud of him.

### **Veteran Bitch (2)**

1. Jarvis, Shannonlee The Woodlark, 7 years, very well made, athletic and substantial, compact but with a certain elegance, VERY pleasing in all departments, great expression and pleasing outline, with level topline, she moved very soundly and with verve, Best Bitch and RBIS and BOS.

2. Barton, Taniswood Summer Rose at Bencorragh, 8 and a half years, very well marked, great body properties, very attractive head and expression, straight in front and good tail carriage, not overly happy in the venue and thus not the super movement of 1.

### **Puppy Bitch (3)**

Three lovely puppies who will change places on many occasions, not surprised to find afterwards that they were all litter sisters. All have a bright future I am sure....

1. Rowles Zendarric Isle of Avalon, well marked with very feminine pretty head and expression, well made throughout, with all to like about her. Needs more confidence and to have a calmer approach, but I see through that, I don't expect youngsters to be automatons, she is a very nice puppy. Excellent level topline, I preferred her head, length of body and finish over croup to 2. BPIS.
2. Walker, Zendarric It's a Kind of Magic Within Wroxham, close up, she is very nicely made, well marked with sound movement, straight in front, and extremely well handled to get the very best out of her.
3. Henton & Plowman, Zendarric Born To Be Wild.

### **Junior Bitch (3)**

1. Tait, Lovenjoel Sleeping Beauty, a very feminine pretty bitch, apparently attending her first show, consequently rather unsettled, but quality will not be denied, well marked and athletically made, very sound purposeful and animated mover, which given her reticence to stand, took me pleasantly by surprise, great depth of body and super angulation throughout, would like her to have a little more length to her back, but I do hope her owner perseveres with her and learns to keep herself calm, which will allow her bitch to settle more.
2. McDonald, Roanjora Montepulciano, close up and very attractive, just preferred rear angulation and cleaner finish to muzzle of 1, moved very soundly, nicely marked, well presented in great condition.
3. Bloxham, Countdown Sweet Coppin.

### **Yearling Bitch (2)**

1. Roanjora Montepulciano
2. Countdown Sweet Coppin, well made throughout, marginally preferred her head to 1, but needs more time to come together.

### **Post Graduate Bitch (2)**

1. Callaghan, Corranroo Coco, very well made, great ribs, symmetric outline, well marked, very pretty head and expression, straight front and decent feet, moved soundly, a very nice bitch without any exaggeration. Res Best Bitch.
2. Pilmer, Anisbrig Kilkerran, pretty head, good outline and rear angulation, moved soundly, preferred front of 1.

### **Limit Bitch (2,1)**

1. Hart, Gilligrae Swift N `Chic, strapping girl, well angulated throughout, nicely marked, very attractive head and expression, straight front and pleasing feet, athletic in build, well presented in great condition.

### **Open Bitch (3,1)**

1. Lorenzi , IT Ch Vistador Bacardi Silver, nice marking and well presented, straight front, moved OK, rather shorter in body and also slightly lighter in eye than I would prefer.
