VETERAN DOG (3,0)

1st./BD/BOS/RBIS Lipscombe's Sh.Ch.Kellizlot River Legend

9 years. Combines quality and substance, masculinity and breed type throughout. Well made head, gentle eye and expression, good head carriage neck and forehead construction. Excellent bone, feet and ribcage, on which he scored. Strong back, powerful loin and coupling, well turned hindquarters. Sound, free mover, maintaining his outline in profile.

2nd. Barry's Rustasha Red Hot Rhumba

7 years. Finer muzzle, intelligent eye and expression. Fair neck and shoulders. Well made body and ribs on which he scored. Strong loin and couplings, good turn of hindquarters. Happy mover once into stride.

3rd. Burgess's Tymaran Huntsmaster.

PUPPY DOG (2,0)

1st/BPD/BPIS Barney & Howatson's Killary's Grand Venture With Vanders And Romaunt

10 months. Attractive, if lightly marked. Quality skull, stop and muzzle. Kind eye and expression, well chiselled below eye, on which he scored. Excellent head carriage, neck and shoulders with correct length of upper arm. Good bone to limbs and feet. Well made ribcage for age. Strong back, loin and hindquarters with well let down hocks. Correct set on and carriage of slashing tail. Skilfully presented and handled to make the most of his free striding, sound movement.

2nd. /RBPIS Barry's Rustasha Golden Rapper

11 months. Smartly marked, promising youngster. Masculine head, well made neck, shoulders and forehead, excellent ribs and body. Good couplings and first thighs. Cheerful mover once into stride. Well presented in good coat and feather.

JUNIOR DOG (5,1)

1st./RBD Wade's Caispern Roddy Owen At Oldstone

Very promising at 12 months. Typical head with good skull, stop and muzzle. Broad nose, dark pigmentation, kind eye and expression. Correct head carriage, neck and lay of shoulder. Good upper arm, legs and feet. Well developed ribcage for age. Powerful back, loin and couplings. Well developed first and second thighs. Moved well with excellent co-ordination in profile, covering the ground with ease. Beautifully presented and handled.

YEARLING DOG (2,0)

1st. Newman's Spiralwood King of Jazz

21 months. Attractive outline, make and shape. Masculine head with gentle eye and expression. Good head carriage, neck and lay of shoulder and upper arm. Well boned legs and feet. Scored in substance to ribcage, on which he scored. Strong back and hindquarters. Moved well with correct profile.

2nd. McDonald's Roanjora Castelao

20 months. Masculine head, good head carriage. Forehand a shade upright. Good body and ribs. Strong topline and co-ordination in profile. Fair hindquarters and tail. Excellent coat and feathers. Skilfully handled.

GRADUATE DOG (3,0)

1st. Barry's Rustasha Golden Rapper

2nd. Newman's Taxus Forest Charmer

Typical head with good skull, stop and muzzle. Kind eye and expression. Pleasing head carriage, forehand construction, legs and feet. Good ribs and body. A shade straight in stifle. Scored in substance and bone. Inclined to pace on the move but sound once into stride.

3rd. McDonald's Roanjora Castelao

POST GRADUATE DOG (3,1)

1st. Lipscombe's Countdown Finnians Rainbow

Well made, masculine head. Excellent skull, stop and muzzle. Broad nose, gentle eye and expression, well set ears. Correct head carriage, neck and forehand angulation, legs and feet. Excellent ribcage and body, muscular loin and couplings, well made first and second thighs, on which he scored. Sound, free mover. Well presented.

2nd. McDonald's Roanjora Castelao

LIMIT DOG (2,0)

1st. Housby's United Spots Royal Eagle Von Vonsonian

Typical head, eye and expression. Excellent pigmentation, broad nose, well set eye and expression. Correct skull and muzzle. Good head carriage & forehand construction. Well boned limbs and feet. Substantial ribcage, on which he scored. Powerful loin and hips. Strong muscles in first thighs. Good coat and feather. Moved well.

2nd. Barry's Rustasha Rhapsody In Red

Smart and stylish in appearance. A shade fine in muzzle. Kind, gentle eye and expression. Fair head carriage and neck, body and ribs. Strong loin, couplings and hindquarters. Firm muscles all through. Moved well. Skilfully handled.

OPEN DOG (3,0) A quality class, hotly contested.

1st. Walpole's Lovenjoel Ice Cool

Masculine head, intelligent, kind eye and expression, good muzzle and ears. Correct head carriage, neck and forehand angulation. Plenty of substance in bone structure throughout, on which he scored. Best of legs and feet. Powerful loin and couplings. Well turned, muscular hindquarters with correct set on and carriage of tail. Sound, free mover. Very honest in every way.

2nd. Walker's Sh.Ch.Vanders Va Voom Avec Wroxham

Masculine, quality head. Kind eye and expression. Strongly constructed forehand, good ribcage and body.

Well turned hindquarters. Scored in strength of pasterns. Moved and showed well. In excellent coat and condition. Handled to best advantage.

3rd. Lamb's Sh.Ch.Casafelice Montadale

VETERAN BITCH (5,1) Another very strongly contested class.

1st. Humphries' Laoirebay All That Jazz Among Spyefire

Feminine head, good skull, muzzle, kind eye and expression, good pigmentation. Strongly constructed forehead, shapely bone and feet. Excellent substance in ribcage, strong loin and hindquarters. Moved well, from all angles, on which she scored.

2nd. Howatson's Sh.Ch.Whispers About Vanders

Excellent over all outline. Sweet head, good eye and expression and skull. Excellent head carriage, neck and angulation fore and aft. Good body and ribs. Scored in topline. Happy, stylish mover. Well presented in good coat and condition. Well handled.

3rd. Housby's Sh.Ch. Tullamore Tiggywinkle.

JUNIOR BITCH (2,1)

1st. Hart's Gilliegrae Swift 'N' Chic

12 months well marked. Shapely muzzle and stop. Occiput a shade prominent. Good head carriage, clean neck and well laid shoulders with fine withers. Shapely, oval bone to limbs. Well made ribcage, strong loin and couplings. Strong hindquarters with correct set on of tail. Moved soundly with good deportment.

YEARLING BITCH (2,0)

1st. Wade's Spiralwood Springtime

21 months. Sweet head, shapely muzzle, eye colour and expression. Good head carriage, neck and forehead. Excellent bone and substance in limbs and body. Scored in bone, substance and strength of pasterns. Muscular hindquarters and good tail. Sound, free mover keeping her outline in profile.

2nd. Farrow's Roanjora Fleurie

20 months. Good muzzle and nose, feminine skull, intelligent eye and expression. Excellent head carriage, neck and forehead angulation. Well built ribcage and body. Strong first thighs. Happy character. A little loose in elbows at present, on the move.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (2,0)

1st. Tong's Rustasha Raison d'Etre For Kellizlot

Typical, feminine head, on which she scored. Good skull, stop and muzzle, dark, expressive eye. Correct head carriage, neck and forehead construction, legs and feet. Excellent body and ribs. Good loin and hindquarters. Moved well, also scoring in freedom and length of stride.

2nd. McDonald's Roanjora Tzarine Tzarina

Feminine head, sweet eye and expression. Good head carriage. Forehand a shade upright. Fair ribs, body, loin and hindquarters. Moved and showed well, just lacking the drive of 1st. Well presented in good coat and feathers.

LIMIT BITCH (6,1) A keenly contested class.

1st. Barry's Rustasha Rosa Kim

Very attractive clear R/W. Good skull, stop, eye and expression. Correct head carriage, neck and lay of shoulder with good upper arm, on which she scored. Well made legs and feet. Excellent substance in ribcage and body. Muscular, well turned hindquarters. Moved soundly with correct stride and outline in profile.

2nd. Hawkins' Corranroo Carousel Over Aislingwood

Feminine head, good nose, gentle eye and expression. Pleasing head carriage, neck and shoulders. Excellent bone and substance throughout. Well made ribcage, strong loin on which she scored. Good couplings and hindquarters. Moved well.

3rd. Barton's Taniswood Summer Rose With Bencorragh

OPEN BITCH (8,2) High quality exhibits throughout.

1st./BB/BIS Humphries' Sh.Ch. Spyefire Seven Steps

Has quality and substance in the correct combination. Feminine head, shapely skull, stop, eye and sweet, gentle expression. Neat ears. Excellent head carriage, clean neck, shoulders and withers. Big ribs, well ribbed back, firm loin and muscular hindquarters. Combines quality and substance throughout. Sound, free flowing mover. Presented in immaculate condition and handled to maximum advantage. Very attractive and full of breed type.

2nd./RBB Hart's IR Sh.Ch. Gilliegrae Cineal Niamh

Well moulded, quality head. Good skull, stop, muzzle. Gentle and kind eye and expression. Good neck and well laid shoulders and upper arm. Excellent substance in legs and feet. Substantial ribcage, on which she scored. Strong back, loin and couplings. Muscular, well turned hindquarters with well good set on and carriage of tail. Moved soundly with a powerful, well co-ordinated stride.

3rd. Hawkins' Countdown Devonshire Dawn Over Aislingwood
