**CRITIQUE**

A really good entry, with remarkably few absentees. A really good sporting atmosphere around the ring, helped make this a really enjoyable appointment. The entry provided some promising youngsters and fully mature grand veterans, being such a slow maturing breed they are also great lasters. I found heads quite variable. Fronts generally still need work, but at least there were a variety of front faults, some it was upright shoulders, others really out at elbow, a few too upright in pastern. Almost all had a level topline, held on the move, and were well ribbed back. Temperaments were great, one even leapt up for a cuddle.

Puppy. D (2)

V promising pups to start.

1st: Green's Zendarric Heart Shaped Box With Vizsaset

Although the youngest he is slightly more mature. Well balanced outline. Head needs time, could be wide in skull and have less of an occiput. Lengthy neck. Better front on the 2, well laid in shoulder and straight legs. V good feet. Well ribbed back. Level topline. Enough hind angulation, just needs a bit more power as he muscles up.

2nd: Walpole's Gallybob Quantum Leap

V nice type and plenty of maturing to do, as they should. Has a really good head, lovely eye and expression. Lengthy neck. Chest to his elbow. Well ribbed. Level topline. Well bent stifle and hock. Just v floppy at the moment on the move.

Junior. D (5,1)

1st: Ball & Harrison's Corranroo Commitment

Well balanced and typy d, not giving his handler an easy time. He has a masc head, well proportioned. Would like more neck. Well laid shoulder and a v good return of upper arm giving tight elbows. Feet could be better. Good depth and fill of chest. Well ribbed back. Level topline. A fraction long in back. Has a v good rear. Best out and back mover in class.

2nd: Walpole's Gallybob Quantum Leap

3rd: Steven's Corranroo Clooney Of Annagh

Post Grad. D (5)

1st: Birch & West's Corranroo Camero at Hitides

Fairly comfortable winner of this class. He has a super profile action and full of style. Typical head, good eye and expression. He has enough neck, well laid shoulder. Elbows could be tighter, feet ok. Well ribbed, good depth of chest. Level in topline. Super rear which he uses so well on the move. Colour excellent. He is a really handsome d, with a lovely outline. CC & BOB

2nd: Ward's Cornadore Argyle With Copperwhite (Imp)

Very typy, honest sort of d. Typical head. Good length of neck. He has quite a good front. Tight feet. Level topline. Well ribbed back to a short loin. His hind angulation matches the front v well. Could be tidier on move, but a decent length of stride.

3rd: Cuddy's Taxus Golden Prince In Balbriggan

Limit. D (5)

Quite a difficult class to sort out as a wide variety of qualities.

1st: Lamb's Casafelice Plezzana

He is a v typy d. Well balanced head with correct width of skull, lovely eye and expression. Enough length of neck. Quite a good front, just a bit too upright in pastern and could have a longer stride. Super body. Level topline. Enough hind angulation, and uses his rear v well.

2nd: Hart's Redmore Diamond Geezer Mit Gilliegrae

He is well angulated front and rear and once settled has a good stride. Has a good width of skull, just a little deep in stop. Lengthy neck. Feet could be better. Chest to his elbow. Could have a firmer topline. Good colour.

3rd: Ward's Courtdown One In A Million

Open. D (5)

1st: Wade's Sh Ch Caispern Roddy Owen At Oldestone

He is a v good type of dog, and like all in this class could have a better front. Well balanced head, good eye and expression. Enough neck. Super body, has depth, well sprung ribs. Level topline. Well made rear. Could be tidier coming towards but has a good length of stride, holding his topline.

2nd: Barry's Sh Ch Rustasha Golden Rapper JW

Well proportioned d. He has a lengthy head. Enough neck. Fair front, although his feet could be better. Well ribbed. A fraction long in loin and can slope v slightly in topline when handler pulls out too far. Well bent stifle and low hocks. Quite a decent mover.

3rd: Barry's Rustasha Rhapsody In Red

Veteran D (1)

1st: Walker's Sh Ch/Ir Sh Ch Vanders Va Voom Avec Wroxham

Really lovely d, v typy. He has a super head, lovely eye and expression. Enough neck. His angulation is well balanced. Good forechest, deep chest, well sprung ribs. Level topline. Enough turn of stifle. Slightly slack in pastern coming towards, v stylish in profile. RCC

Good Citizen D ne

Minor puppy. B (3)

All real babies but with lots of promise.

1st: Bayne's Corranroo Consort

She has a lovely outline and a super colour. Fem head. Lengthy neck. Could have slightly better lay of shoulder. Grand body. Level topline. Well made rear. Fairly accurate out and back.

2nd: Martin's Corranroo Cascade at Shannonstyle

She too has a v good outline and is so feminine. Head needs to develop. Enough neck. Quite a good front, feet need to improve. Super body. Level topline, held on the move. Well made rear.

3rd: Wade's Oldestone Charlie's Angel

Puppy. B (2)

1st: Walker's Zendarric It's A Kind Of Magic Within Wroxham

Raw but promising baby with a super temperament. She has a fem head. Lovely eye and expression. Lengthy neck. Upright in pastern and feet could be tighter. Well ribbed back. Level topline. Well made rear with low hocks. Just needs to mature and muscle up. BP

2nd: Martin's Corranroo Cascade at Shannonstyle

Junior. B (4,2)

Both raw.

1st: Soper's Lovenjoel Belle Of The Ball

Preferred her head. She has a dark eye and kind expression. Lengthy neck. Still needs to develop chest. Ribs go well back. Level topline. Well made rear which she uses so well.

2nd: Bloxham's Countdown Sweet Coppin

She has a v good outline. Could have more depth of muzzle and lip be slightly more squared off. Lengthy, crested neck. Ok front and good feet. Level topline. Low hocks. Just a bit narrow going away, but time for this to improve.

Post Grad. B (5)

1st: Callaghan's Corranroo Coco

V nice b for type and the best front in class. Good balance of muzzle to skull, she is v slightly dished though. Good neck. Has super feet. Level topline. Well bodied for her age. Well bent stifle with low hocks. Moves fairly well.

2nd: McDonald's Miss R Roanjora Montepulciano

V raw. She has a v good head. Super eye and expression. Could have better angulation of shoulder and upper arm. Ok body for her age. Level topline. Moderate hind angulation. Ok out and back mover. Super colour, presentation and temperament.

3rd: Pilmer's Anisbrig Kilkerran

Limit. B (3,1)

Both v different from each other.

1st: Walton's Gallybob Bedazzled

She has a v good outline and uses herself better on the move than 2. Fem head, could have a little more stop. Lengthy neck. Well filled front and v good feet. Well ribbed back. Level topline.

Moderate turn of stifle. Quite good out and back.

2nd: Hart's Gilliegrae Swift N'chic

She had the better head. Super neck. Fair front. Feet flat. Chest to her elbow. Topline could be firmer. Correct hind angulation. Ok out and back.

Open. B (6,1)

1st: Barry's Rustasha Rosa Kim

V lovely b. She has a fem head, could have a little more depth and be slightly more squared in muzzle. Good neck. Well laid shoulder, good return of upper arm and elbows well placed. Level in topline. Well sprung ribs. Good turn of stifle with low hocks. Could be a bit tidier out and back but v good in profile, where her topline never faltered. CC, understand this was her title, well done.

2nd: Tong's Rustasha Raison D'etre for Kellizlot

She has a v good outline. Super head. Lovely eye and expression. Enough neck. Shoulders could be laid back more and feet better. Super body. Level topline. V good rear. Quite good out and back, not the stride of 1.

3rd: Humphries' Sh Ch Spyefire Seven Steps JW

Veteran B (4,1)

1st: Barry's Sh Ch Shireoak Hurricane Ruby Rustasha (Imp)

Really lovely b of 11. Super outline, which she holds on the move. She has a lovely head. Good neck. Well made front. Grand body. Level topline. Good rear. Maybe her red is not as rich as it once might have been. Super profile mover. RCC behind what turned out to be her granddaughter.

BV

2nd: McDonald's Roanjora Chianti JW

V good outline and her better front took her here. She has a super head. V good neck. Chest is slightly shallow. Super topline. Well bent stifle with low hocks. Colour could be clearer.

3rd: Jarvis' Shannonlee The Wood Lark

Good Citizen B (4,2)

1st: Farrow's Roanjora Fleurie

She is pleasing for type. Liked her balanced angulation. V fem.

2nd: Soper's Caispern Winning Colors

V well balanced, if rather too moderate front and rear. Fem head. Enough neck. Needs more forechest. Well ribbed back and holds a level topline.
