CRITIQUE

I was pleased with the quality of the dogs presented today. The nature of the entry ensured that youth would do well! So I was surprised that the only general point I will highlight is poor dental hygiene, normally associated with older dogs.

Junior Dog {3} An excellent first class.

1. CUDDY'S TAXUS GOLDEN PRINCE IN BALBRIGGAN. A mature looking dog of real substance with a particularly good top line. On the move he was enthusiastic until the challenge when he decided it was time to play! Well muscled and with excellent body proportions. BD.
2. BALL AND HARRISON'S CORRANAROO COMMITMENT. A very stylish puppy. Particularly impressive outline. He needs to develop muscle tone as he currently rolls when moving but this will come with exercise. Scored over the other dog puppy present as he is already so well together. BP.
3. COLLINS'S ROMAUNT BLOOMIN GRAND AT FORESTPOINT.

Post Graduate Dog (2)

1. FARRIN'S CAISPERN CAPTAIN CHRISTY. Smart looking smaller built and very typey boy. Good head. Showed particularly good muscle tone and muscle development. He does need to body up though. Great colour.
2. TAYLOR'S LAOIREBAY MIDNIGHT DRIFTER. An enigma! This is a big framed dog who is a work in progress. Needs to body up and put the meat on those bones as he currently appears quite rangy. Head is lovely and strong. Movement was good in patches.

Limit Dog (2) It was a close call between these.

1. TATTERSALL'S ALANEA GAME WARDEN. Well built big dog who looked the part. Nice outline. Moved well and kept his topline on the move. RBD.
2. HART'S REDMORE DIAMOND GEEZER MIT GILLEIGRAE. Similar build to class winner. Colour is well defined. Lost his topline when moving.

Junior Bitch (1)

1. TATTERSALL'S KILLARYS CLASS ACT AT ALANEA (IMP), In good condition and well bodied for such a youngster. Lovely soft expression. Just needs to keep developing.

Post Graduate Bitch (2,1a)

1. EDDLESTON'S RUSTASH RED HOT DIVA. Smaller built girl. Very deep chest but barrelling of the ribcage could be more pronounced. Coat is long and of good quality. Movement was very good with clear reaching action from the front. RBB.

Limit Bitch (4,2a)

1. TONG'S RUSTASHA RAISON D'ETRE FOR KELLIZLOT. Compactly build and sturdy. Liked her head and has a pretty expression. Nothing out of place nor exaggerated. Well muscled and moved with real drive. BB and BOB.
2. HART'S GILLIEGRAE SWIFT N' CHIC. A big built girl but carrying more weight than she needed which impacted on her movement. Front assembly is notably good.
