I was delighted to see very positive movement both coming towards and going away with elbows tight and width between the hocks, that is until the Open Bitch class were the above let some down badly.

1st: Cuddy's Taxus Golden Prince. Lovely sharp white coat with deep red patches, round in eye kind expression, clean neck, good angles with ample bend of stifle A sound pup as was the second.
2nd: Wade's Roanjora Teroldego. A more mature youngster with a spring of rib and is deep in body, good head carriage, free long stride gait, sound on handling.

1st: Taxus Golden Prince.

1st: Pilmer Anisbrig Tobermory. Lovely free long striding action, very good rear drive, carries enough rib with length, top line held on the move dark round eye has arch to neck, sound oval bone balanced head piece, pleased all through.
2nd: Owen's Anisbrig Tamdhu. Stands on good bone, tight arched feet level backline, tail well set very clean action coming towards, sound on handling.

1st: Mcdonald's Roanjora Castelao J.W. Shown in excellent condition, very much in proportion throughout, Good bone with tight feet, neck flows to level top line, good colour, I liked his head piece with finish of muzzle, covers his ground to advantage.
2nd Hart's Redmore Diamond Geezer Mit Gilliegrae. Carries good body proportions with both spring and depth in body, dark round eye. Like him to be a little cleaner coming towards, side gait and going away was very sound.
3rd Mawhinney's Paralexix Jovial Jasper.

1st: Wade's Caispern Roddy Owen at Oldstone. Took the CC&BOB. Won well, Great profile lovely masculine headpiece, Very athletic and so positive ground covering movement, stands four square, a honest male with much to admire, very typical setter.
2nd: Lamb's Casafelice Plezzana. Stands over his ground to advantage, very good bone, tight compact feet, shows well, in condition, super ground covering side gait, pleased in head and expression.
3rd: Barry's Rustasha Golden Rapper J.W.

O.D.

1st: Lamb's Sh Ch & Ir Ch Casafelice Montadale J.W. Res CC. Very sound on handling, Gives a very good balanced profile, I liked his head and expression has forechest he is well bodied up, good bend of stifle with width of thigh, Moved out with a positive action.
2nd: Griffin's Sh Ch Casafelice Cheviot. Shows to advantage if just a little unsettled, covers a lot of ground, has substance in body and rear quarters, head carriage and topline held, went with lashing tail.
3rd: Barry's Rustasha Rhapsody In Red.

1st: Mcdonald's Roanjora Montepulciano. Very much a baby of six months, when settled held herself together well with good movement for age. feminine in head, kind eye a pleasing puppy.

J.B.

1st: Pilmer's Anisbrig Kilerran. Good forechest, she is well bodied up with ample width in rear quarters. Moved true elbows kept tight, good forward reach with a sound driving action, pleased in head and expression.

P.G.B.

1st: Lockwood's Lockenna Gold Dream, lighter made all through but she has a good spring of rib and moved very well, clean length of neck and has width of thigh.

L.B.

1st: Tong's Rustasha Raison D'Etire for Kellizlot. Moved out really well when she settled, long free stride, the best muscled R/W on show today. Feminine headpiece carries a good spring of rib, well coupled to sound wide quarters which she used to advantage.

O.B. Wards's Sh Ch Ballakinnish Mischief Making Copperwhite J.W. Stood out today for her typical, sound and true movement, I was pleased to award her the Bitch CC. A bitch with lovely balanced proportions throughout. Very kind in eye and expression, showed to advantage, a pleasure to handle.

2nd: Humphries Sh Ch Spyefire Seven Steps J.W. Took Res bitch CC. A bitch of substance, Straight oval bone, carries a good length of rib, she is well angulated in rear quarters, covers plenty of ground keeping a flowing outline, pleased in head with finish of muzzle.

3rd: Barry's Rustasha Rosa Kim.
