CRITIQUE

It was a great pleasure to judge Irish Red & White Setters today. My thanks to all the exhibitors who brought their dogs under me. I was very pleased with the overall standard of the dogs, some of whom I consider to be excellent examples of the breed. Previously I commented on the number of bad mouths and tail kinks that I have come across when judging. I was really pleased to find no mouth faults. But I was quite concerned to find several tail kinks. Breeders need to be aware that this is a fault that must be dealt with when considering a mating. There were also quite a few dogs with large, flat feet. The majority were very well presented both in coat and in muscular condition

Minor Puppy Dog (1)

1st Taylor's Laoirebay Midnight Drifter.

A well grown seven month old boy. Lovely bone and substance. Quite short-coupled and a little steep in croup. Head still developing as would be expected at this age, but he has a very pleasant eye and expression. His coat is a nice rich red but with quite a lot of flecking. He moved very soundly for such a baby.

Puppy Dog (5)

1st, Best Puppy & Res CC. Wade's Caispern Roddy Owen at Oldestone.

I absolutely loved everything about this young man. He has it all The only thing he needs is time.

There is no doubting that he is all male with excellent head and dark expressive eyes. Nicely arched neck with correct front and rear angulation. Strong topline with good tail set and carriage. He has good spring of rib and depth of chest.

His colour is ideal, clear pearly white and rich red. His excellent, sound movement was the icing on the cake. It was a very close decision between him and his sire for the CC.

2nd Barry's Rustasha Golden Rapper. Another lovely puppy with good head and expression. Slightly more mature than the winner. Correct topline and tailset. Excellent depth and spring of rib. His beautiful coat colour really sparkled. Well balanced throughout. Failed in front movement.

3rd Taylor's Laoirebay Midnight Drifter.

Junior Dog (1)

1st Rustasha Golden Rapper. As above.

Limit Dog (4)

1st Walpole's Lovenjoel Ice Cool. Very nice overall type and quality. Well sprung ribs, with good forechest and depth of chest. I felt that he was overweight, which affected his shoulders, topline and movement. Good colour.

2nd Green's Courtdown Field of Dreams for Vizsaset. Masculine head with kind expression. Good neck and shoulder with ample forechest and depth. Good rear angulation and very well muscled. Moved very well. Beautifully presented dog. I feel that his best has yet to come.

3rd Barry's Rustasha Rhapsody in Red.

Open Dog (3)

1st & CC Wade's Sh Ch Ballakinnish Malachi at Oldestone. I thought this boy was really super. He was just what I was looking for in a mature Irish Red & White Setter. He combines correct breed type with strength and power. His movement was spot on, a testament to his excellent conformation. He is the sire of the Puppy Dog and Puppy Bitch winners. I see that he is out of the very beautiful Sh Ch & Ir Sh Ch Ballakinnish Mistinguette to whom I awarded the CC at Crufts. His sire Sh Ch Tullamore Troubador is also a favourite.

2nd Lamb's Sh Ch & Irish Sh Ch Casafelice Montadale JW. Beautiful head and soft expression. Good spring of rib, depth of chest and forechest. Strong legs and well muscled hindquarters. Neat, well cushioned feet.. Beautiful coat and colour in sparkling condition. Moved very well.

3rd Walker's Sh Ch Vanders Va Voom avec Wroxham.

Veteran Dog (2)

1st Ward's Caispern Nicolaus Silver cum Copperwhite JW ShCM. At 10 years old this boy is in super coat and condition. Very well made with sound, active movement. Strong, masculine head with soft expression. Neat, well cushioned feet.

2nd Barry's Rustasha Red Hot Rhumba. A well-balanced 8 year old. Presented in beautiful coat and condition. Just failed in head to the winner. Another boy with neat feet. Moved very soundly.

Puppy Bitch (4)

1st Henderson's Temyloah Zoe. Lovely head with such a sweet expression. I loved her front assembly and depth of chest. Very well balanced, moved positively with drive. Presented in beautiful coat. Lots of fun ahead with this little lady.

2nd Hart's Gilliegrae Swift n' Chic. Sweet head and expression. Good shoulder, forechest and spring of rib. Beautiful colour and very well presented. Not moving as well as winner.

Post Graduate Bitch (4)

1st Rowles' Vanders Crimson Velvet. Beautifully presented coat that actually glistened. Correct, feminine head with sweet expression. Nicely arched neck, good front assembly and depth. Just a bit steep in croup. Moved really well with good extension and drive. A quality bitch.

2nd Wade's Spiralwood Spring Time. Good front assembly, but rather high at the rear and straight in stifle. Good colour. Moved very well.

3rd Tong's Rustasha Raison D'Etre for Kellizlot.

Limit Bitch (6)

1st & Res CC Barcroft's Ballakinnish Muse. A lovely bitch with everything in proportion. Correct head with dark, expressive eyes. Good length of neck. Good topline, shoulder and rear angulation, with excellent movement. Good colour.

2nd Bayne's Corranroo Cruz. Beautiful, feminine girl who was presented to perfection.

Very nice head with sweet expression. So well balanced. I just preferred the movement of 1.

3rd Walton's Gallybob Bedazzled.

Open Bitch (9)

1st & CC Tubby's Taniswood Anything Goes. I really loved this girl. So well balanced throughout with the added bonus of having excellent movement with correct extension and drive. Very pleasant head and expression. Good bone and substance. Her coat is a beautiful, rich red with pearly white. She is all quality.

2nd Jarvis' Shannonlee the Woodlark. Another very nice girl with similar attributes to the winner. Very sound movement. I preferred the head and expression of the winner.

3rd Ward's Sh Ch Ballakinnish Mischief Making Copperwhite JW.

Veteran Bitch (5)

1st Howatson's Sh Ch Whispers about Vanders. Best Veteran. I thought she was beautiful! At twelve years old she was in top show condition. She has everything in proportion. Her movement was a credit to her overall balance and of course to her owner, who has her looking so well. I was not surprised to see that my PG Bitch winner was her daughter.

2nd Ward's Copperwhite Cinnamon. Strong, well made girl who is also looking very well for her years. She moved very soundly, but unfortunately had to give way to the winner today.

3rd Webb's Sh Ch Shannonlee the Skylark JW.
