### **Post Graduate - Dog**

This was a tricky class to judge as you could make a case for all four exhibits.

**1ST Hart's** REDMORE DIAMOND GEEZER MIT GILLIEGRAE. Good head, typical with width and correct balance. Strong neck of good length, sloping shoulders, well boned front, Well balanced body. He has good depth and width of chest as well as a firm topline which he held on the move.

**2ND McDonald's** ROANJORA CASTELAO JW Close up to the winner. He too has a good head with width and length of foreface. Good reach of neck leads to well laid shoulders. Firm in topline with good couplings. He has strong well-angulated quarters. I just thought the winner had a little more depth on chest at the moment. This will surely come.

**1ST Wade's** CAISPERN RODDY OWEN AT OLDESTONE At 19 months, this one is coming together nicely. Loved his head! True to type with width and balance, dark eyes and good ear placement. Good neck and shoulders. Well boned legs with good feet. Strong quarters for his age. Moved steady and true. Just lacked the maturity and finish in the challenge.

**2ND Tattersall's** ALANEA GAME WARDEN Litter brother to my Best of Breed. Good head with balance and a kind expression. Well-laid shoulders. Good depth and width of ribs, plenty of rear angulation. I preferred the topline of the winner today.

### **Open - Dog**

**1ST Walker's** SH CH VANDERS VA VOOM AVEC WROXHAM Thought this seven year old looked the part today! Lovely head with enough worth but not too coarse. Good ear placement, clean neck of good length

leading into well angulated shoulders. Well boned front. Good length and depth of chest, firm couplings giving a well-balanced body. Strong quarters with good rear angulation, moved well especially in profile showing extension at both ends. He definitely looked the part today. A pleasure to award him the CC.

**2ND Walpole's** LOVENJOEL ICE COOL, another good one, true to type and looking well. Lovely head neck and super layback of shoulder. Well-developed ribcage and has strength over the loins. Moved well round the ring. Preferred the stifle of the CC winner but his qualities and maturity took him to the RCC ahead of some promising youngsters. Worthy of his title.

**3RD Wade's** SH CH BALLAKINNISH MALACHI AT OLDESTONE

#### **Junior - Bitch**

**1ST Pilmer's** ANISBRIG KILKERRAN At 14 months, shows promise; Good head feminine but with enough width, long clean neck, good shoulder angulation, good depth of chest for her age, well-angulated stifles. Moved well, just needs to tighten as she matures.

**2ND Mallinson's** ANISBRIG AILSA BAY Sister to the winner but different in type, finer throughout. Pretty head with correct ear placement. Straight front legs of good length, needs to fill out as she matures.

#### **Post Graduate - Bitch**

**1ST Wade's** SPIRALWOOD SPRING TIME This one is well put together and now needs to fill out to complete the picture. Correct balanced head with good reach of neck and well laid shoulders; she has a level topline and good tailset. When settled on the move, she showed good rear extension.

**2ND Chapman's** BALLAKINNISH MOULIN ROUGE A different type with a lot to like about her. Good head with width and a defined stop. Correct length of neck, Good shoulder placement and strong quarters with good tail set. I felt that she lacked the positive hind movement of the winner today. Close up.

**3RD Eddleston's** RUSTASHA RED HOT DIVA

**1ST Barry's** RUSTASHA ROSA KIM Really liked this 4 year old. Correct head with width and square in muzzle. Super, balanced outline. Strong clean neck of good length, not overdone. Well laid shoulders. Super body properties, short strong couplings with firmness over her loins giving a correct topline and tailset. Strong quarters with well bent stifles and good second thigh. Moved well to win this class. Pushed the CC winner all the way. RCC today, must surely gain her title.

**2ND Tong's** RUSTASHA RAISON D'ETRE FOR KELLIZLOT Another top quality one and so many of the remarks of the winner apply to her, my notes are so similar. I really liked her head, neck and shoulders. Balanced body with width and depth. Firm topline. Just felt the winner had the edge on the move today. Close to top honours.

**3RD Whitaker's** LOWDON LIGHT SHIFT TO VIEWLAND

#### **Open - Bitch**

A super class with no less than five champions present.

**1ST Tattersall's** SH CH ALANEA SUMMER COTTAGE, This one had everything that I was looking for. Definitely an Irish Red and White in type. Good head with enough width and a square muzzle yet still feminine throughout. Strong clean neck with enough length and well laid shoulders. At only 2 years has width and depth to her body. She has short couplings and a firm level topline. She has well angulated quarters with a good bend of stifle and hocks well-let down. She moved well and was presented in super coat and condition. CC Best of Breed and Group 2 – Well Done!

**2ND Sherratt's** SH CH CASAFELICE CORMO AT CHARNBOROUGH This well balanced 7 year old looked really well today. She has a short strong body showing the required athleticism, good neck and shoulders. Straight well-boned front legs. Well angulated quarters which were enhanced by good muscle development. A worthy Champion.
