CRITIQUE**DOGS:**

Puppy 1. Birch & West's – Corranroo Camero at Hitides. 8 months old, his bite will need checking in the coming months to see if it will end up a correct scissor bite and hopefully with a bit more time all will be OK. Good overall shape and balance. Pleasing head with good shaped eye and typical expression. Well sprung ribs for one so young. Adequate lay of shoulder but would like more upper arm. Tight fitting elbows. Good bend of stifle. Moved steadily when settled. BP.

Junior 2 1. Barney & Howatson's – Killary's Grand Venture With Vanders & Romaunt (Imp USA). Real quality from nose to tail with I would say a lot more to come when he fully matures. Loved his height to length proportions which gave him excellent balance with no exaggerations. Masculine head with that slightly naughty expression. Good eye shape and colour. Good reach of neck flowing into the withers. Well laid back shoulders. Strong topline. Well developed hindquarters. Once he settled I could see that he had good drive from the rear and excellent forward reach. Has a tendency to lift his front legs slightly higher than he needs to. He is full of life which made it hard for his handler who coped well. Loved his temperament and style. CC.
2. Barry's – Rustasha Golden Rapper. Not so positive on the move than 1. He is more mature than 1 but not quite in the same league as yet. Liked his head and expression which is very typical. Presents a very balanced outline with no exaggerations. Good body proportions.

Post Grad 4 (0abs) 1. Tattersall's Alanea Game Warden. One who excels on the move which is controlled and positive. Good size and well angled at both ends with deep brisket giving him excellent balance. Mature masculine head with kind, intelligent expression. Good width of thigh and bend of stifle. One who will get better and better with age. Tight feet and strong pasterns. RCC. 2. Rustasha Golden Rapper. 3. Lipscombe – CourtDown Finnians Rainbow.

Limit 1. Barry's – Rustasha Rhapsody In Red. Needs to body up a bit more. Pleasing head with intelligent expression. Moderate length of neck. Adequate lay back of shoulder. Strong level topline which quite a few exhibits didn't have today. Good forehand construction. Very short of coat. Strong, well developed hindquarters which he uses to advantage to drive round the ring. A little careless with his front on occasions. Would like to see him a little more sympathetically handled.

Open 1. Walpole's – Lovenjoel Ice Cool. I loved this dog's head and kind, intelligent expression. Mature body with good proportions. Deep in brisket. A bit down in pasterns. Strong, level backline and loin. Covered the ground with ease and style.

Veteran Bog or Bitch 4 (1abs) 1. Lipscombe – Sh Ch Kellizlot River Legend. Great shape and balance.

Possesses many qualities. So well put together. Masculine head with typical expression. Mature body properties. Good shoulder placement. Moved well on balanced strides. Very stylish. A worthy title holder. 2. Barry's – Rustasha Red Hot Rhumba. Not so good in shoulder placement. Quite racy in appearance. Liked his height to length proportions. Good bone and feet. Strong level topline. Moved truly in both directions. 3. Ward's – Caispern Nicolaus Silver Cum Copperwhite JW SHCM.

Good Citizen Dog or Bitch 2 (1abs) 1. Soper's – Caispern Winning Colours. Fine all over. Sweet, feminine head. Friendly temperament. Difficult to assess her movement.

BITCHES:

Puppy 2 1. Callaghan's – Corranroo Coco. Quite raw at this stage and lost out to litter brother for BP. Preferred head of this one over 2 which was more typical. Not so good in shoulder placement but this did not prevent her from moving freely on a loose lead. Attractive markings. Short in couplings. Good bone and feet. Head was so feminine and had lots of work in it. Good breed type. 2. Mallinson's – Anisbrig Ailsa Bay. Quite a fine head and could have less occiput. Scopey and elegant outline. Good length of couplings. Well developed hindquarters which she used to advantage on driving round the ring with good forward reach to match.

Post Graduate 3 (1abs) 1. Tong's – Rustasha Raison D'etre For Kellizlot. A lot to like about this one. Well put together with many breed type qualities. Classical head with intelligent expression. Good height to length proportions giving her a balanced outline with no exaggerations. Firm topline. Covered the ground with ease and style and excellent forward reach. 2. Caispern Winning Colours.

Limit 5 (2abs) 1. Tattersall's – Alanea Summer Cottage. Loved her balance and elegance. Feminine head but her right eye was weeping which detracted from expression. Superb forehand with hindquarters to match. Deep in brisket with well sprung ribs. Good length of neck. In lovely coat and condition. Very stylish on the move but a bit proud of her tail which slightly spoilt her in the challenge. Excellent breed type. 2. Barry's – Rustasha Rosa Kim. Mature and well developed. Good body properties. Presents a very balanced outline. Attractive, feminine head. Could have a better shoulder placement. Well sprung ribs and level topline. Good width of thigh and bend of stifle. Would like to see more drive from the rear. Liked her type. 3. Lyus's – Lovenjoel Christmas Spirit.

Open 8 (1abs). At last something I could get my teeth into. 1. Blackmore's – Sh Ch Countdown Beautiful Dancer. This was the one for me as I found her so well put together and balance personified. She possesses all the breed attributes. Classical Head with so much work in it. Kind, intelligent eye. Excellent height to length proportions giving her total balance with no exaggerations. Well angled at both ends. Good bone and feet. Covered the ground with style. A worthy title holder. CC & BOB. 2. Hawkins – Countdown Devonshire Dawn Over Aislingwood. Litter sister to 1. Slightly more mature looking than 1. Many of the same attributes as her sister. Good reach of neck. Liked her front assembly. Well off for substance. Strong over the loin. Used her well muscled hindquarters to push off from the rear. Balanced forward reach. RCC

DOGS:

Puppy 1. Birch & West's – Corranroo Camero at Hitides. 8 months old, his bite will need checking in the coming months to see if it will end up a correct scissor bite and hopefully with a bit more time all will be OK. Good overall shape and balance. Pleasing head with good shaped eye and typical expression. Well sprung ribs for one so young. Adequate lay of shoulder but would like more upper arm. Tight fitting elbows. Good bend of stifle. Moved steadily when settled. BP.

Junior 2 1. Barney & Howatson's – Killary's Grand Venture with Vanders & Romaunt (Imp USA). Real quality from nose to tail with I would say a lot more to come when he fully matures. Loved his height to length proportions which gave him excellent balance with no exaggerations. Masculine head with that slightly naughty expression. Good eye shape and colour. Good reach of neck flowing into the withers. Well laid back shoulders. Strong topline. Well developed hindquarters. Once he settled I could see that he had good drive from the rear and excellent forward reach. Has a tendency to lift his front legs slightly higher than he needs to. He is full of life which made it hard for his handler who coped well. Loved his temperament and style. CC.

2. Barry's – Rustasha Golden Rapper. Not so positive on the move than 1. He is more mature than 1 but not quite in the same league as yet. Liked his head and expression which is very typical. Presents a very balanced outline with no exaggerations. Good body proportions.

Post Grad 4 (0abs) 1. Tattersall's Alanea Game Warden. One who excels on the move which is controlled and positive. Good size and well angled at both ends with deep brisket giving him excellent balance. Mature masculine head with kind, intelligent expression. Good width of thigh and bend of stifle. One who will get better and better with age. Tight feet and strong pasterns. RCC. 2. Rustasha Golden Rapper. 3. Lipscombe – Courtdown Finnians Rainbow.

Limit 1. Barry's – Rustasha Rhapsody In Red. Needs to body up a bit more. Pleasing head with intelligent expression. Moderate length of neck. Adequate lay back of shoulder. Strong level topline which quite a few exhibits didn't have today. Good forehand construction. Very short of coat. Strong, well developed hindquarters which he uses to advantage to drive round the ring. A little careless with his front on occasions. Would like to see him a little more sympathetically handled.

Open 1. Walpole's – Lovenjoel Ice Cool. I loved this dog's head and kind, intelligent expression. Mature body with good proportions. Deep in brisket. A bit down in pasterns. Strong, level backline and loin. Covered the ground with ease and style.

Veteran Bog or Bitch 4 (1abs) 1. Lipscombe – Sh Ch Kellizlot River Legend. Great shape and balance. Possesses many qualities. So well put together. Masculine head with typical expression. Mature body properties. Good shoulder placement. Moved well on balanced strides. Very stylish. A worthy title holder. 2. Barry's – Rustasha Red Hot Rhumba. Not so good in shoulder placement. Quite racy in appearance. Liked his height to length proportions. Good bone and

feet. Strong level topline. Moved truly in both directions. 3. Ward's – Caispern Nicolaus Silver Cum Copperwhite JW SHCM.

Good Citizen Dog or Bitch 2 (1abs) 1. Soper's – Caispern Winning Colours. Fine all over. Sweet, feminine head. Friendly temperament. Difficult to assess her movement.

BITCHES:

Puppy 2 1. Callaghan's – Corranroo Coco. Quite raw at this stage and lost out to litter brother for BP. Preferred head of this one over 2 which was more typical. Not so good in shoulder placement but this did not prevent her from moving freely on a loose lead. Attractive markings. Short in couplings. Good bone and feet. Head was so feminine and had lots of work in it. Good breed type. 2. Mallinson's – Anisbrig Ailsa Bay. Quite a fine head and could have less occiput. Scopey and elegant outline. Good length of couplings. Well developed hindquarters which she used to advantage on driving round the ring with good forward reach to match.

Post Graduate 3 (1abs) 1. Tong's – Rustasha Raison D'etre For Kellizlot. A lot to like about this one. Well put together with many breed type qualities. Classical head with intelligent expression. Good height to length proportions giving her a balanced outline with no exaggerations. Firm topline. Covered the ground with ease and style and excellent forward reach. 2. Caispern Winning Colours.

Limit 5 (2abs) 1. Tattersall's – Alanea Summer Cottage. Loved her balance and elegance. Feminine head but her right eye was weeping which detracted from expression.
