JD (3,1a)

1 Barry's Rustasha Golden Rapper, pleasing head & square in muzzle, lovely round eye, medium neck flowing into a good topline, straight front, correct oval bone, tight feet, moved well;
2 Wade's Caispern Roddy Owen at Oldestone, not so mature as 1. Balanced head with a lovely dark eye, good shoulder & topline, strong quarters with a good turn of stifle & let down hocks, moved well.

1 Lipscombe's Courtdown Finnians Rainbow, well shaped body flowing into strong quarters, good forechest, deep in brisket & ribs well sprung, lovely round eye with a soft expression, good oval bone & tight feet, moved well, good coat colour. BD;
2 Hart's Redmore Diamond Geezer mit Gilliegrae, a close decision. Lovely head & eye, correct neck flowing into a good topline, deep in chest, well turned stifle & let down hocks, good coat, moved sound;
3 R Golden Rapper.

OD (3)

1 Barry's Rustasha Rhapsody In Red, head balanced. Would have liked more width of foreface. Good reach of neck flowing into a well placed shoulder, deep in body, good topline & tailset, clear in coat, moved sound with drive. RBD;
2 Lipscombe's Sh Ch Kellizlot River Legend, this 9 years old boy is a credit to his owner. Lovely head, good shoulder & topline, well angulated quarters, good oval bone & correct feet. Not moving as well as 1;

3 Ward's Caispern Nicolaus Silver cum Copperwhite.

PB (1)

1 Callaghan's Corranroo Coco, I thought this bitch was impressive, so very feminine, lovely head, eye & expression, good oval bone & tight feet. Her coat gleamed. Good turn of stifle. Needs to settle in movement. Would think she has a bright future. BP.

JB (1) 1 Hart's Gilliegrae Swift N'Chic, pleasing head. Would like a better front & feet. Level topline flowing into strong quarters & let down hocks, put down in good order. RBB.

PGB (4,2a)

1 Wade's Spiralwood Spring Time, lovely head, neck flowed into a well placed shoulder, deep in chest, straight front with oval bone. Feet could be better. Strong quarters. Could have moved better;

2 Tong's Rustasha Raison D'Etire for Kellizlot, balanced head with round eye & pleasing expression. Correct topline, flowing into strong angulated quarters.

OB (2)

1 Ward's Sh Ch Ballakinnish Mischief Making Copperwhite, I loved this bitch, just wish she moved with more enthusiasm but her other virtues outweighed this. Lovely head, neck flowed into a good shoulder & topline, deep in body & well sprung ribs, straight front, good oval bone & tight feet, strong quarters. Moved sound with drive. BB & BOB;

2 Barry's Rustasha Rosa Kim, preferred head of 1. Has good bone & correct topline, good spring of rib & deep, pleasing quarters, moved well with drive.
