CRITIQUE

VD/B (3,2)

1st: Barry's Sh Ch Shireoak Hurricane Ruby Rustasha (Imp). BV. A lovely balanced bitch with lots of breed type. For 11yrs old in such good condition and could certainly show some of the youngsters how to move. Clean neck and shoulder into well made front with good bone. Well balanced head not showing any signs of aging other than her colour fading. Moved off well with a free open gait in profile and didn't loss her balance.

PD (2)

1st: Ward's Cornadore Argyle With Copperwhite (Imp). BP. A maturer dog than the second by a good few months. A well balanced head, which needs to break a little more, and would prefer a softer eye. Well boned. Correct straight front with good lay of shoulder with a correct clean neck flowing into a level topline. Well bodied with a correct depth of brisket to the elbow. Moved off well would like a little more rear angulation. Good coat and colour and in good condition.

2nd: Stevens Corranroo Clooney Of Annagh. At 6 months old, lost out on maturity to 1st. Lovely kind eye, head and expression. Good bone and tight feet. Plenty of body for his age and good strong loin and spring of rib. Well made forehead. A bit loOse on the move, and the handler could do with a little more time at training classes and plenty of encouragement from the breed.

JD (2)

1st: Cuddy's Taxus Golden Prince With Balbriggan. RBD. Good quality dog with plenty of the required substance. Good clean outline, in super body, well sprung rib and strong loin, keeping a level topline on the move. Well made rear construction with good angulation. Strong masculine head with well balance proportions, preferred to 2nd. Good coat and colour.

2nd: Ward's Cornadore Argyle With Copperwhite (Imp)

PGD (4) 1st: McDonald's Roanjora Castelao JW Sh.CM. The most polished performer on the day, who moved well both fore and aft and kept a well balanced picture in profile. Shame all his girls at home were in season, just lacking the body I'd like. Good bone and feet, good colour and coat texture. Correct spring of rib and length of the loin. Level topline. Pleasing head and expression with a kind eye.

2nd: Bailey's Rustasha Golden Rhythm. Liked the type of this dog with plenty of substance, well ribbed and good loin. Liked his head and expression and proportions. Good oval bone and feet. Just didn't move that well, didn't seem settled.

3rd: Barrett's Rustasha Golden Riviera.

LD (4,1)

1st: Barry's Rustasha Golden Rapper JW. BD. A quality dog with lots to like about him. Well balanced with good make and shape. Well bodied with a good spring of rib. Lovely head and expression with correct stop and kind setter eye. Correct straight front and good oval bone. Moved off well and kept a well balanced picture in profile with a correct open gait. Super coat and colour.

2nd: Green's Countdown Field of Dreams for Vizaset. Lost out on movement to 1st. Again another well-balanced dog. Good head proportions with a kind eye and expression. Well made front with good bone and feet. Well bodied and in good hard condition.

3rd: Bailey's Rustasha Golden Rhythm.

OD (3,1)

1st: Barry's Rustasha Rhapsody In Red. Preferred the elegance and pose of this dog to 2nd. Clean lines throughout with flowing lines through neck and shoulders, into a well made forehead with good bone and feet. Lovely head and expression, typical setter head. Level topline, with good spring of rib and length of loin.

Would like a little more rear angulation. Good clear colour and well presented and handled.

2nd: Walpole's Lovenjoel Ice Cool. Pleasing masculine head and expression. Some good qualities to like about this dog. Good strong topline and plenty of substance all through. Good bone and feet. Didn't have the movement of 1st.

PB (1)

1st: Soper's Lovenjoel Belle Of The Ball. A well balanced raw feminine baby girl when stacked. A good straight front with plenty of bone. Good rear angulation with a good well sprung body and depth of brisket. Pretty feminine head and expression. Would like a little bit more all over but might come with age. Plus a little more reach and drive on the move both ways.

JB (2,1)

1st: Soper's Lovenjoel Belle Of The Ball

PGB (2,1)

1st: Soper's Caispern Winning Colors. Pretty feminine head. Well ribbed and good bone, clean neck and shoulder. Moved well. Would just like a bit more all over for this bitch for her age.

LB (3,2)

1st: Tong's Rustasha Raison D'Etre for Kellizlot. A quality bitch who has improved so much since I judged her as a real youngster. Good strong topline with a well ribbed body and strong loin. Super head and expression with well balanced proportions. Well made rear construction and showed on the move with some drive behind.

OB (4)

1st: Humphries Sh Ch Spyefire Seven Steps JW. BB & BOB. A lovely example of the breed who has fulfilled her promise since I gave her BP. Super quality head and expression full of type. Good clean outline with good straight front and oval bone into good feet. Well let down behind. Good clear colour and coat condition. Well presented and shown to her full advantage.

2nd: Hawkins Corranroo Carousel Over Aislingwood. RBB. Another quality, typey feminine bitch who gave 1st a run for her money. Again well bodied with plenty of substance, well ribbed and good strong loin holding the correct level topline. Moved freely keeping a well balanced picture in profile. Pleasing head and expression.
