Masculine, strong quality bone. Good head shape, moderate neck into well-built front. Good rib, strong in loin and well angled rear. Strongly built but balanced and in good condition and when settled, moved with good stride.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Hart's Gilliegrae Time T'shine**

Liked the type and overall shape. Slightly finer built throughout at this stage in his development. Presented in good condition and moved steadily.

**YEARLING DOG (1)**

**1<sup>st</sup> Barney's Romaunt Lust For Life**

Masculine balanced head with good eye and muzzle and well set ears. Liked his type, shape and balance. Good bone and stands on good feet. Athletic in appearance and presented in very good condition. Comes to life on the move holding a nice outline when covering the ground on good, free, athletic action. Needs time but should do really well in the future.

**LIMIT DOG (5)**

**1<sup>st</sup> Tattersall's Carrick Shadow Dog At Alanea (Imp Pol)**

Liked the head shape, bone and body. Good depth, firm topline and well set tail. Presented in good condition and has lots of breed attributes. Very together on the move, holding a balanced outline when covering the ground with nice free action.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Catton & Cook's Daithi Shadow Dog With Ferngate (Imp Pol)**

Another quality exhibit of good breed type, size and shape. Liked his bone, head and body. Also presented in good condition and close to 1<sup>st</sup> but needs to gel more with its handler on the move.

**OPEN DOG (6)**

**1<sup>st</sup> Cuddy's Sh Ch Taxus Golden Prince In Balbriggan JW (C.C. & B.O.S.)**

Headed this lovely class. Masculine, balanced head with dark eye. Muscular neck into well laid shoulders. Good bone, depth of body and strong in loin. Good width in rear and well set tail. Stands on good feet. Presented in good coat of very good colour and covered the ground with free stride, holding a balanced outline.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Gardner's Sh Ch Alanea Game Reserve With Danwish (R.C.C.)**

Close to winner, also a balanced dog with good quality bone, good head. Firm topline and well set tail. Presented in good condition, also has much to appreciate. Covered the ground well with good stride.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Ward's Cornadore Argyle With Copperwhite (Imp Pol)**

#### **VETERAN DOG (1)**

##### **1<sup>st</sup> Bayne's Corranroo Casper (B.V.I.B.)**

10 years and in fabulous condition for his age. Liked his type, shape and overall balance. Good breadth of head with good stop. Dark eye of good shape. Moderate neck, good depth of body. Presented in good body condition with good coat. Moved with a steady stride and nice side gait. Nice that he went on to Reserve Best Veteran in Show.

#### **FIELD TRIAL DOG OR BITCH (1)**

##### **1<sup>st</sup> Brooke's Drumlace Shadow In Earnest**

13 month old female. With good head. Good depth and overall shape. Needs time to fill in and finish the frame but had a nice free action on the move.

#### **PUPPY BITCH (2)**

##### **1<sup>ST</sup> Jakins & Knox's Coolfin Ailbhe**

Headed this lively class because she was most together out of the two pups working with her handler more. Liked the head, bone and overall shape. Has good breed type and has lots of promise but needs to get more together on the move.

##### **2<sup>nd</sup>: Gibson's Coolfin Aoife**

Slightly smaller caste but liked her shape and type. Also has a good head and depth of body. Presented in good condition and also needs to come more together on the move to show off the virtues.

#### **JUNIOR BITCH (4,1A)**

##### **1<sup>st</sup> Gardner's Charnborough Charisma Of Danwish (R.C.C.)**

Feminine head of good proportions, with good stop and eye shape. Ears well set, moderate neck into well laid shoulder. Liked the bone, depth and rib. Well angled rear, tail well set and stands on good feet. Presented in good condition. Moved around the ring with good free action. Has lots of breed attributes and still needs a little more time to complete the picture.

##### **2<sup>nd</sup> Jones's Settersay Heatwave**

Another feminine lovely head. Good neck into well-proportioned body. Good bone, rib and firm in outline when covering the ground with good free action. Presented in very good condition.

Lovely type, shape and bone. Good head and eye. Presented in good coat and condition. Has lots to like but for unfortunately her mind was not on the job in hand today.

**POST GRADUATE BITCH (4 2A)**

**1<sup>st</sup> Tait's Talintyre Winter Spice**

Feminine head of good quality. Liked her bone, rib, strength of loin and well set tail. Good width in the rear. Presented in very good coat and condition and held a nice picture when covering the ground with good free action.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Soper's Canterbyred Miss Magic**

Liked the shape and type of this exhibit. Balanced head, good legs and length of body. Well set tail. Has much to like but just needs time to fill in the required picture. Covered the ground steadily.

**LIMIT BITCH (4, 1A)**

**1<sup>st</sup> Barney's Romaunt Carry On Regardless With Verrami**

Good head shape and eye. Well set ears. Clean neck. Good body shape, depth, quality bone and well angled rear. Liked her type, size and covered the ground with a free action.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Tattersall's Alanea Silhouette**

Good head and body shape. Liked her breed type and size. Moved steadily around the ring. Not as finished as 1st today.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Henson's Ianbro Corellian Calypso Tatsbro**

**OPEN BITCH (7, 3A)**

**1<sup>st</sup> Tait's Sh Ch Lovenjoel Sleeping Beauty (C.C. & B.O.B.)**

Feminine head of good breadth Good stop and muzzle. Dark eye and well set ears. Clean muscular neck into well-built front. Good depth and spring of rib. Muscular back and rear. Well set tail. Quality bone and close knit feet. Presented in good coat and body condition. Covered the ground with long, free stride showing reach in front and drive from behind.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Barney's Romaunt Ain't Life Grand**

Another feminine exhibit presented in good condition. Liked the head shape and expression. Good neck and depth of body. Strong in loin and well angled rear. Good size and well set tail. Also has strong bone. Moved steadily with good drive from the rear.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Walker's Sh Ch Zendarric It's A Kind Of Magic Within Wroxham JW**

**VETERAN BITCH (2, 1A)**

**1<sup>st</sup> Whitaker's Lowdon Light Shift To Viewland**

10 years with nice feminine head. Has good bone and stands on good feet. Liked her eye and expression. Liked her size and a real extrovert as she went round the ring. Credit to her owners to have her in lovely condition.
