Puppy Dog (1, 0)

1st: Hart's Gilliegrae Time T'Shine

BP. A very immature youngster and needs to firm up on the move. Good clear colour. Super legs and feet, with a good depth of brisket and spring of rib. Well bodied. Pleasing head and typical R&W expression.

Post Graduate Dog (2, 1a)

1st: Cook & Catton's Daithi Shadow Dog With Ferngate (Imp Pol).

Liked this boys head and expression. Good strong muzzle without any flew. Nice crest in the neck which lead to well ribbed and bodied young man. Correct amount of bone and correct feet. In good coat and condition. Moves well in profile and drives off well behind covering the ground. I'd like a little more 2nd thigh. He needs to fill in his loin which will only come with age.

Limit Dog (4 1a)

1st: Green's Zendarric Heart Shaped Box With Vizsaset,

DCC. A good class, with 3 different types. Preferred the balance and maturity of this dog. Cleaner in his neck and shoulder. Good bone and feet. Correct depth of brisket and well ribbed back. Moved off well behind with drive. Kept a good balanced picture in profile with a good topline. A pleasing head and expression which has only got better with

age.

2nd: Tattersall & Jones' Carrick Shadow Dog With Alanea (Imp Pol).

A little heavier in type and not quite the head of 1st. Correct bone and good straight front. Well ribbed and depth of brisket. Moved well in profile. Would like a little more bend of stifle.

3rd: Martin's Laoirebay Steel Blue Ocean At Shannonstyle JW

Open Dog (3 1a)

1st: Birch & West's Sh Ch Corranroo Camero at Hitides

RDCC. Liked the overall balance of this dog. He moved well with a good foot fall. A mature dog with a super IRWS head and expression with a melting eye. Coat needed a little attention. He was a little lethargic in the challenge for the CC.

2nd: Jakins & Knox's NL Ch Terne Des Coris Qalimero At Coolfin JW (Imp Bel)

Beautiful head and expression and has matured well since I gave him BP the last time I did the breed. He is still young and needs to mature in his loin and drop a little more. Moved well, but does like his tail. Good bone and feet with a clean neck and shoulder.

Puppy Bitch (1, 0)

1st: Jakins & Knox's Coolfin Ailbhe

She took a while to settle on the move. Good bone and feet for her age. Clean through her neck and shoulder into a correct depth of brisket and fore chest. Feminine head with a nice eye. Can tell who her father is!

Junior Bitch (2, 0)

1st: McDonald's Roanjora Rioja Crianza

Lovely mover in profile just flew round the ring with an open gait. Unfortunately wearing her bikini today. Bone and substance in proportion to her make and shape, good forehead into a good lay of shoulder. Like a slightly firmer topline which may come with age, and I would like more of her all over.

Yearling Bitch (1 0)

1st: Hart's Berryessa Ballderg with Gilliegrae

Correct bone and feet with plenty of body and spring of rib. Well made rear construction with nice bend of stifle. A feminine head and expression, head just needs to break which will come with age. Moved out well with good foot placement.

Post Graduate Bitch (3 2a)

1st: Hodgetts' Alanea Obsession of Hodgehall

A pretty bitch with a nice expression. Would like a little more depth of muzzle. She was well bodied with a good spring of rib and depth of brisket. Kept a good level topline on the move. Correct moderate rear construction which showed on the move away from you. Would like a slightly better lay of shoulder. Well presented and handled.

Limit Bitch (2 1a)

1st: McDonald's Roanjora Montepulciano

A very alert and keen mover. Correct bone, with a good clean neck and shoulder. Pleasing head and expression with a good kind eye. Clear markings. Little a little more angulation at the rear.

Open Bitch (2 0)

1st: Tattersall's Sh Ch Alanea Summer Cottage

BCC & BOB and short listed in the Gundog group. The most exquisite head and expression. Lovely eye and good ear set. So clean through her neck and into a good lay of shoulder. Correct spring of rib and depth of brisket. Correct loin into a well made rear construction. Clean markings with islands of red. So balanced on the move, keeping a level topline and showing herself so well, the tail never stopped. It was lovely to judge her this time and whilst she is now just a veteran she oozes quality throughout.

2nd: Walker's Sh Ch Zendarric It's A Kind Of Magic Within Wroxham

RBCC. This bitch has really matured well and her head has much improved. A lovely mature bitch in good body with correct bone and feet. A good make and shape with a well balanced picture created in profile. Her movement wasn't quite as good as the 1st, the ring certainly didn't help her and handler. But no hesitation to give her the RCC.
