A breed that I really enjoy judging having had an association with them since the early 90's through the late Pat Brigden and Pauline Perriam. Two great ladies of the breed who taught me a lot when I was young. It's very encouraging to see how the breed has improved in many ways including front movement. This is far tidier these days than in the past and only bodes well for the breed. Breeders need to be mindful that they are an athletic breed and not racy, some are bordering on Irish setters with red and white coloured coats. Having said that I was very pleased with the entry and had some super quality exhibits to judge. I was delighted to hear that the Dog CC winner gained his crown today as I don't think I have ever seen him before.

Puppy Dog (2)

1 Tattersall's Alanea Mirror Image. Very promising youngster who is typical in outline and showing super type. Masculine and well proportioned head with a gentle expression and dark eye. Athletically put together with a well made front assembly, good depth to his chest and well ribbed back. Firm in topline and a well set tail. Super quarters for a youngster with well bent stifles and good muscular development. Super colour and well marked. On the move he was steady and had a super footfall. Covering the ground with ease and using himself well. Pleased to award him RCC and Best Puppy.

2 Jakins' Coolfin Murchard. Slightly bigger frame to this chap. Pleasing head of good proportions, eyes still need to darken which they should as he matures. Good reach of neck and well placed shoulders, still needing to tighten in front. Well ribbed back and firm in topline. Quarters well muscled and standing on good legs and feet. Quite heavily

in the topline. Quarters well muscled and standing on good legs and feet. Quite heavily marked but this did not detract. Moved with drive and covered the ground, just needed to settle a little.

Post Graduate Dog (3,2)

1 Barney's Romaunt Lust For Life. His name is well matched with him as he was certainly enjoying himself today and pushing his handler to the limit at times. Lovely head and eye, masculine without being overdone, squareness to foreface and a gentle expression. Strong neck leading to well placed shoulders and enough return of forearm. Depth to forechest, well ribbed back and firm in loin. Quarters developed and super muscle tone. Stands on good legs and feet. He moved covering the ground well but a little exuberant on the out and back and throwing his front.

Limit Dog (3)

1 Stevens & Turner's Corranroo Clooney Of Annagh Very smart and typy dog, initially his handler was fighting with him on the stack, however once he settled he made a superb shape which came to life on the move. Super head of correct proportions good width to the skull and finish to foreface. Strong neck which led neatly into his shoulders and a correctly proportioned return of forearm. Forechest is deep with ribs well sprung and back to a firm loin. Topline level and maintained throughout and correct finish to the croup. Good bend to the stifles and super muscular development. On the move he had an accurate footfall and covered the ground in an easy open side gait, maintaining his outline. My pleasure to award him the CC which I understood later was his 3rd, well done and deserved.

2 Titterton's John Spyefire Reyt Bobby Dazzler. Good type of dog with balanced proportions. Pleasing head and expression, would prefer a slightly darker eye. Clean through the neck and shoulder and enough return of forearm. Well bodied with good spring to the ribs and firm in loin. Croup slopes slightly to his tailset. Quarters developed and used to advantage on the move. Covered the ground well just needs to settle in front as he comes towards you.

3 Catton & Cook's Daithi Shadow Dog With Ferngate (Imp Pol).

Open Dog (5,1)

1 Tattersall & Jones Carrick Shadow Dog With Alanea (Imp Pol) Typy and athletic in appearance, super colour being pearl white with defined red patches. Masculine in head, wouldn't want any more strength in back skull, good finish to the foreface. Good front assembly with depth to foreface. Straight front and well boned legs. Ribs well back and firm in loin. Level topline and good finish to the croup. Would like a little more bend of stifle and width through thigh. Moved in a steady fashion placing his feet well.

2 Green's Sh Ch Zendarric Heart Shaped Box With Vizaset. Clean in outline and standing over ground. Pleasing head with enough width to the skull, would like eyes a shade darker. Good reach of neck and well placed shoulders, good depth and ribs well back. Slight slope to his topline and croup. Quarters well bent and muscled up well. Well presented and in super condition.

3 Martin's Laoirebay Steel Blue Ocean At Shannonstyle JW.

Veteran Dog (1)

1 Wade & Wade's Sh Ch Caispern Roddy Owen at Oldestone. What a super type this chap is, full of quality, typical in outline, no doubting his athletic appearance. He has a cracking head and expression, so typical in proportions and expression. Beautifully constructed throughout and your hands simply flow over him. Would have been a real contender for top awards, however when asked to move he said "No" and just stopped.

Puppy Bitch (1)

1 Tattersall's Alanea Savannah. Litter sister to PD winner and very similar remarks apply, not as forward as her brother at this stage but full of potential and quality. Beautiful head and

expression. Constructionally put together very well and plenty of bone and substance. On the move she is accurate and steady. Two very nice pups from this breeder.

Junior Bitch (1)

1 O'Neill's Pol Mavoureen Shadow Dog (Imp Pol) Handler and charge are new to showing and doing a good job so far, just need to practice and polish up the performance. Clean in outline and needing to fill her frame somewhat. At this stage a little fine throughout and in very hard condition, needing to build her up and fill her frame. Topline and outline clean and on the move, once settled, she placed her feet well and covered the ground.

Post Graduate Bitch (2)

1 Brooke's Drumlace Shadow in Earnest (IKC) Clean in outline and presenting a feminine picture, substance and athletic without being overdone. Pleasing in head, would like a shade more width and a darker eye to be picky. Lovely reach of neck which fitted into her shoulders well, straight front well boned legs and neat feet. Depth to forechest and well ribbed back. Quarters developed and firm. Moved covering the ground with an open side gait.

2 Gibson's Coolfin Aoife. Presented a balanced outline. Head has decent proportions and raised brow. Strong through the neck, angulation balanced fore and aft. Level topline, well ribbed and firm in loin. Quarters used to advantage on the move. In profile she covered the ground, not as tidy in front action as the winner.

Open Bitch (3,1)

1 Gardner's Sh Ch Charnborough Charisma Of Danwish JW Star of the day today and what a cracker she is. Full of quality, type, and balance. Feminine head which has the correct width of skull to balance her foreface, which is slightly squared. Delightful expression, a hint of spirit in her eye. She flows through the neck and shoulders to a good return of forearm. She now has the correct depth of chest, and her ribs are well sprung and back to a firm and powerful loin, meaning that her topline is level and never falters. Super finish to the croup and well set on tail. She has the right amount of width to her thigh and stifles are well bent. On the move she went around on a loose lead, head carriage a delight and footfall to match, effortless and free flowing. Could not be denied CC and BOB.

2 Sherratt & Blackwell Sherratt's Sh Ch Alanea Holly Fern At Charnborough. I see that she is the dam to Charisma and she certainly has passed on many attributes. Gorgeous head with a soft expression, well proportioned with the correct width of skull. Clean and strong in neck which led to well placed shoulders and a good return of forearm. Enough depth to
