Special Field Trial Bitch No Entries

Thanks to the committee for the invitation to judge our Championship Show having exhibited at most of them for the last 37 years it was indeed an honour and pleasure to judge. It was also a time to reflect on just how much our breed has changed as well as the changes happening in our hobby.

Thank you to Rita & Karen my stewards on the day but most of all thank you to the exhibitors for entering under me in these financially difficult times.

I hope you will accept my critique for the purpose it is intended. I found a couple of bad mouths and at this level of competition condition and coat presentation needs to be faultless too.

As one of the custodians of our breed my critique is to evaluate and to make observations that I hope will be recognised as a way to continue to improve and maintain our breed.

Veteran Dog (4,3)

1st Green's Sh Ch Zendarric Heart Shaped Box With Vizaset. (BD.BVIS/RBIS /BOS)

7year old. Typey and well balanced. Very much like his mother's line. His head is moderate in every aspect. Broad enough skull to be in proportion to his head, moderate stop with a good length to muzzle, flews slightly cut away, giving a head which is a series of soft curves. His eyes are correct shape and the colour compliments his colouring. His neck is moderate and strong. Well placed shoulders giving a well-developed forechest. Straight front with correct oval bone and reasonably good feet. He has a good spring of rib for his overall build. Level topline. Tail set on correctly. Correct rear angulation with a moderate bend of stifle and short hocks. He moved well covering the ground efficiently. Shown in clean condition and in good coat. Pleased to award him the CC, RBIS &BVIS

Yearling Dog (1,0)

1st Tattersall's Alanea Mirror Image. Well, what a stocky little man. Just 18m old and has all the makings of a R & W. He has a different but still a very attractive head, correctly broad skull again in proportion, moderate stop and good length to muzzle, would just prefer a little bit less depth to flews. He has a well-shaped eye, dark in colour and a very soulful expression, however this head will be changing for years to come. His neck is moderate in length and very strong. He has strong well laid back shoulder and good forechest. A very level top line and well developed rib and good depth to chest, however I would prefer a bit more length to loin and more angulation from hip to hock with a slightly shorter hock. His tail is set low. He was shown in gleaming condition and moved proficiently but would like to see a bit more rear extension. Having said all that a very nice dog who will be developing and changing for years to come.

Graduate Dog (2,0)

1st Hoogendijk's Simply Red And White Shane. This dog has a lot of development to do. He's a bit of a handful and tries too hard to please and as a result can on occasions look completely unbalanced. His body proportions are correct. His head overall is pleasant, the length of skull is in proportion to his muzzle, however his width to skull is just a little too much. I liked the shape of his muzzle, not too deep and with that slight characteristic cut away. His neck is of moderate length and strong and his shoulder placement could be marginally better. He has plenty of forechest. He is well off for correct oval bone. His feet could be tighter. He s got a well-developed rib with good depth to chest. His hindquarters are strong however do slightly drop away off the croup. He moved well with good rear extension in a happy fashion.

2nd Catton, Cook & Jakins's Coolfin Clancy With Ferngate. 2 year old heavier type. He has a strong head,

his skull is rather broad. He has a lovely dark eye of correct shape which gives him a soft, kind expression. He has a moderate stop and square muzzle, I would prefer less depth to flews. He has a moderate length neck which is strong and muscular. He has good front angulation and is well off for bone. He is deep chested with a good spring of rib however he is not carrying enough weight for his frame. He has a good length to loin with strong muscular hindquarters and a moderate bend of stifle. His feet could be tighter. He covered the ground well on the move

Limit Dog (2,0)

1st Catton & Cook's Daiti Shadow Dog With Ferngate (Imp Pol). Overall a nicely presented dog in good coat and condition. Pleasant head. His skull is broad in correct proportion to his body, he has a moderate stop and his muzzle is a tad long but of good depth. His eyes are of good shape and dark but has a kind expression. His neck is of ample length and muscular. His front assemble is tidy, well laid back shoulder, plenty of fore chest, strong bone and straight front. His feet could be better. He has a well sprung rib. He is slightly short in loin and would prefer stronger hindquarters with more weight and angulation, also his tail set is low. He moved well with a happy disposition.

2nd Macpherson's Roanjora Jacquart With Rokeover. Bit of a surprise this one. Not really presented in show condition however what a very nice dog. He has a lovely head of correct proportions. A moderate stop and square muzzle, slightly deep for me but overall it was all in proportion. Correct shape eye giving a good expression. His neck is strong and of good length. His shoulders are well laid back and muscular. Well off for forechest and correct oval bone. He has a well-developed rib and strong loin, well angulated hindquarters and moderate rear pasterns. Moved well covering the ground with ease. I think this dog could do really well.

Open Dog (2,0)

1st Hoogendijk's Dutch Ch Jww18 Jch Simply Red And White Runar. I was quite taken by this boy. He's a smaller dog but oozes breed type. He has the correct shape and balance for the breed. He has correct front and rear angulation. His ribs are well developed and good depth to loin which is also long enough to balance his body shape. He has correct oval bone and I liked the sweep of his hindquarters which were strong and muscular and his tail set was correct. His head is not what we commonly see today, however his skull is broad in proportion to his body (remember what I said at the beginning) his ears are set high his eyes are round. His muzzle could be a tad longer and wider. Presentation could be better. He pushed very hard for the CC and I was very pleased to award him the RCC. I think he would be an interesting dog for British judges who are unfamiliar with the breed to see.

2nd Gardner's Sh Ch Alanea Game Reserve With Danwish. Presented in immaculate condition. His head is broad and strong with strong stop and his muzzle is deep but with a slight cutaway with softens his head. His eyes are dark and kind. He has a strong neck of good length and his shoulders are well positioned and muscular. He has a good fore chest and strong straight front with good bone. His ribs are well developed and deep. I'd have preferred him to sit deeper into his hindquarters giving better angulation and top **line. His movement was free striding and he covered the ground with ease.**

Special Field Trial Dog (1,0)

1st Green's Flores Henry Tudor By Vizaset.(BSFT). His head is a little long and lean at the moment but he has a moderate stop with the correct shaped skull his eyes are dark with kind expression. His head will develop with time. He has a very good reach of neck which is clean and muscular. His shoulders are well angulated and well developed. His ribs are well sprung with good depth. He has a reasonable length to loin. Would prefer stronger hindquarters with more angulation. His feet are tight and well-shaped. He's a bit lean for me however I appreciate he is worked. His coat was in excellent condition and tip top presentation.

Junior Bitch (2,1)

1st Reynolds-Crompton's Gilliegrae Hidden Mystique. She has a pretty head, correct shape to skull with moderate stop. Her eyes are of correct shape and dark giving her a gentle expression. She has moderate bone, her shoulder placement is good and she has a reasonable spring of rib with good depth. She has correct length to loin and her hindquarters are well developed with moderate angulation. She has very good tight feet. She was presented in excellent condition. Her movement was a little erratic but that was mainly due to inexperience. Lovely to see new people in the breed I hope we see them both again.

Yearling Bitch (1,0)

1st Tattersall's Alanea Savannah. Very typey. Strong head with broad skull and moderate stop, good length and width to muzzle. A kind eye and correct set ears which are well coated. Her neck is strong and muscular leading into strong muscular and well positioned shoulders. She has plenty of fore chest

and a good straight front with plenty of heart room. She has strong bone and reasonably tight feet. She has a strong well developed spring of rib, well covered. Would prefer a little more length to loin and a little more sweep to hindquarters which are well muscled with an ample width to thigh. She moved well covering the ground in a powerful fashion. She's well developed throughout a real little power house.

Novice Bitch (2,1)

1st Onley's Morrigan Shadow Dog (Imp Pol). Good size bitch, well bodied up. Her skull is broad but feminine, she has a reasonable stop, her muzzle is a little long, however heads change and develop all the time. She possesses correctly shaped eyes of good colour, giving a soft expression. Lightly boned and would prefer more fore chest. She has excellent colour with a lovely amount of good patches. She is well ribbed up and has a good width to her hindquarters, however would prefer more angulation from hip to hock and tighter feet. On the move she strode out well with good rear extension when settled. She was shown in excellent clean condition.

Another new team within the breed, both handler and dog have many qualities and I hope the handler perseveres and continues to learn his craft. Well done!

Graduate Bitch (3,1)

1st Jackson's Taxsus Rising Spring. This girl has a good length to height ratio, she is well developed all through. Her skull is broad in proportion to body, she has a moderate stop and good depth to muzzle. Her eyes are correct in shape and colour. Her head is strong but feminine. Her shoulders are strong and powerful with good muscle and she is well developed in fore chest. Her bone is oval and plentiful. Unfortunately her feet are quite loose. She is well developed in rib and holds a level top line. She has a strong hindquarter with good width to thigh and moderate angulation, her tail is set on correctly and she moved efficiently.

2nd Gibson's Coolfin Aoife. A strongly set girl, slightly squarer shaped girl as a little shorter in loin, however everything in proportion. Her skull and muzzle are both broad and square separated with a definite stop. Her ears are moderate length and set on correctly. Her neck is of moderate length, clean and strong, leading into muscular shoulders. Her front is straight and well boned. Would prefer tighter feet. She has a level top line with a well-developed spring of rib of good depth. Would prefer her to be slightly shorter in stifle to hock area. She has good tail set. Her white is very clear and she has good colour. She moved confidently around the ring.

Post Graduate Bitch (1,0)

1st Henson's Isleen Shadow Dog At Tatsbro (Imp Pol). Good size bitch, nicely balanced with a level top line. Her head is feminine with good skull to muzzle ratio and she has a moderate stop. The depth of her muzzle is moderate with a characteristic cutaway, all of this combined with balanced facial markings, correct eye shape and colour gives for a very pleasing feminine head. Moderate length to neck with correct shoulder angulation and fore chest. Slightly lighter in bone and not the best of feet. She has a good spring of rib and muscular hindquarters. Presented in lovely condition and moved with reach and drive.

Open Bitch (4,1)

1st Gardner's Sh Ch Charnborough Charisma Of Danwish JW.(BCC/ BIS) Classic bitch, very much in the distinct mould of a red and white setter. Natural head carriage. Her skull and muzzle are in proportion, a selection of gentle curves and moderate stop. Her muzzle is deep enough to give balance and substance and yet not too deep to appear heavy or coarse. Her eyes are gentle and of good colour, giving a very feminine expression. Her neck is longer than some, however it is strong and complements to her balance. Her shoulders are very well positioned and well covered. She has a good spring of rib and her top line is level. She has sufficient bone, however her feet could be tighter. She has well developed hindquarters with a good width to thigh, moderate bend of stifle her tail is set on well. Her coat is plentiful and of correct colour and texture. Her movement is free flowing and effective. Very pleased to award her the BCC as I did her mother and then award her BIS. Congratulations!

2nd Barney's Sh Ch Romaunt Carry On Regardless With Verrami. (RBCC)

What a lovely little bitch, plenty to offer. Her head is of correct dimensions and proportions, however just a bit squarer and stronger than the BCC. Her neck is moderate in length but strong and clean. Her shoulders are well placed and muscular with a well-developed fore chest. She has a good length to leg which is well boned, her feet could be tighter. She is strong in back with a well-developed spring of rib, nice depth to loin. Her hindquarters are strong and muscular with moderate angulation. She moved with drive. Her coat is of correct colour with good patches of colour. Her depth of coat and furnishings were a little sparse but did nothing to detract from her quality. Pleased to award her the RCC.
