Delighted with all the dogs I had the opportunity to judge, they are all a real credit to you.

Junior Dog (1)

1 Tattersall's Alanea Mirror Image - Cracking happy and outgoing 17 month old dog, still a little raw but certainly one to watch for the future. He presents a shapely and balanced outline, with a lovely flow to him. He has a delightful head, clean cut and beautifully balanced. Good length of neck with a slight arch, firm level topline, falling away a fraction at the croup. Well bodied, with the brisket well let down, and a good development of forechest. Strong and muscular hindquarters which he put to good use on the move to show good drive and clean rear movement. Lovely pearly white coat and rich red patches. A star of the future.

Graduate Dog (1)

1 Cornwall & Licence's Settersay Tornado - Pleasing dog, if a bit of a fidget! who is coming up 3 years of age and has the balance of substance and athletic stature. Liked his head, it has good planes, defined stop, a hazel eye of good shape. Good length of neck with a slight arch, not quite the depth and forechest, good oval boned limbs. He holds a firm and level topline both stood and on the move, falling away a little at the croup. Nicely muscled hindquarters, moving out with good drive once settled. Well presented.

Limit Dog (1)

1 Taylor's Laoirebay Monte Carlo - Nicely balanced, 5 year old dog without any exaggeration. He has a pleasing outline when stood with harmonious proportions. Lovely head, masculine with good width to the backskull, correct planes, and a well shaped eye to give a kind expression. Good length of neck, with a slight arch, well developed through the ribcage and deep in brisket. Holding a firm topline, and his hindquarters are strong and muscular. Moved on an easy stride, and well presented in a pearly white jacket with rich red patches.

Open Dog (5.1) Lovely class, all with many fine qualities.

1 Ward's Sh Ch Cornadore Argyle with Copperwhite (Imp Pol - Lovely quality 8 year old, who is such an honest and sound dog. He presents a pleasing outline when stood, balanced all through and showing good proportions. He has the desired strength and substance, but retains his athleticism. Nicely balanced head, with a lovely dark eye giving a gentle expression. He has good depth to the brisket and well developed forechest. Standing on strong oval boned limbs and neat feet. Keeping a firm topline both stood and on the move. Hindquarters show a good length from hip to hock, with a muscular wide thigh. On the move, he has an easy stride, with positive footfall. Presented in a lovely jacket – Pleased to award him DCC & BOS.

2 Tait's Sh Ch Talintyre Winter Shadow - Super 3 year old dog, who is of a nice overall size, impressive outline on the stack, and looking on great form. Masculine head, with good width to the backskull, good stop, well placed ears, and a kind gentle expression. He has a lovely flow, with a slight arch to the neck, well placed shoulders, and a firm level topline, falling away slightly at the croup. Super depth and forechest, forelegs strong and straight with a slight slope to the pastern. Strength to his hindquarters with a wide hammy quarters. Positive and true on the move, a fraction higher in his tail carriage, but flows around the ring. Pearly white coat with rich islands of red - RDCC.

3 Titterton's Spyefire Reyt Bobby Dazzler

Junior Bitch (2,0)

1 Tattersall's Alanea Savannah - Quality 17 month old, and litter sister to JD winner. A little more compact in her outline than 2nd. She has the most beautiful head, balanced, clean cut and so very feminine. Super depth to the brisket and fill in of forechest, well sprung ribs that are carried well back with a short loin. Today tending to lose her topline a little. Stands on good oval boned limbs and neat feet. Moderate hindquarters with a good width of thigh and in lovely muscle tone. She is accurate in her footfall, and moves at one with her handler. Beautiful pearly white to her coat.

2 Barney's Romaunt Ain't Misbehaven - Of a different type to winner, but also a quality bitch. Only 14 months and a little raw at present. Think she will be like a fine wine, and blossom into a beautiful girl. Liked her overall shape and balance, and she has a lovely flow to her outline. Balanced in her head, with a good width to the backskull and length to the foreface. Neck flowing smoothly into a firm and well held topline. Brisket is down to the elbow, not quite the fill in of forechest of winner. Good oval bone, feet a little flat at present. Liked her hindquarters, stifles well bent with a good width of thigh. A happy mover, just needing to tighten a little more in front.

Limit Bitch (1,0)

1 Hart's Berryessa Ballderg with Gilliegrae - This 3 year old bitch has so much potential. Liked her substance all through, but retaining her feminine elegance and athletic appearance. She has a lovely head, clean cut and balanced, nicely squared flews, with a gentle dark eye. Good length of neck with a slight arch, well developed through the body, good length to the ribcage, today tending to roach her topline, a fraction longer in loin. Super hindquarters, wide and strong with a good bend of stifle. Well presented with good colouring, nicely handled. Showed herself off on the move, driving from the rear.

Open Bitch (3,0)

1 Sherratt's Sh Ch Alanea Holly Fern at Charnborough - Top quality bitch, coming up 7 years of age. She has lovely graceful lines, beautiful balanced, and all in proportion. Each part flowing seamlessly into the next. When stood she is a picture of unexaggerated symmetry. Lovely head piece, correct planes, good length to the foreface and toning gentle eyes. Clean neck of good length, brisket down to the elbow, good spring to the ribs which are carried well back to a firm loin She holds her topline, firm and level both stood and on the move. Stifles are well bent with a wide thigh. Shown in super coat and condition. On the move positive and true – Delighted to award her BCC & BOB.

2 Gardner's Sh Ch Charnborough Charisma of Danwish JW - Another cracking bitch, 2 years old, and I see she is the daughter of the winner. Presenting a pleasing outline, with the right amount of substance and an athletic stature. Liked her balanced head, good length to the foreface, definite stop and dark eye and pigmentation. She has a lovely flow from nose to tail, with a deep brisket and well sprung ribcage. Lovely firm level topline held at all times. Moderate bend of stifle, with good muscle tone. A pleasure to watch on the move, showed good drive and true fore and aft - RBCC. 3 Talintyre Winter Spice (Tait).

Veteran Bitch (1,0)

1 McDonald's Roanjora Montepulciano - Such a delight to judge this 8 year old bitch, so happy and outgoing. She is in fine fettle and looking the best I have ever seen her. Liked her overall proportions, she is well balanced, with good substance yet retains her femininity and is athletic. She has an appealing head, very proportionate, with good width to the backskull and length to the foreface, dark correctly shaped eye. Good length of neck flowing into a firm topline and well set on ever wagging tail. Ribs are well sprung and carried well back. Corresponding angulation fore and aft, rear showing a good width of thigh. Moving out with lovely drive and at one with her handler. Presented with a lovely pearly white jacket, just lacking a little feathering today. In the mix for top honours - BV
