Puppy Dog (1,0)

1st Tait's Talintyre Fomhar Reiver. 9 months old with a lovely head, dark round eyes and a good square muzzle, good oval bone and nice feet, level top-line and correct tail set, good colour, moved out well and I felt he shows a lot of promise, BPD & BP.

Junior Dog (1.0)

1st Holgate's Hodgehall Don't Stop Me Now with Rogansrock. Just out of puppy by a week, another nice young man with a lovely head, dark and round eyes and correct pigment, I liked his length of neck and sloping shoulders, good bone, top-line and tail set correct, moved out well in the big ring, another who shows promise.

Post Graduate Dog (1,0)

1st Catton/Cook/Jakins' Coolfin Clancy with Ferngate. Loved his head with dark round expressive eyes, square muzzle and well set ears, good neck and shoulders and level top-line, well off for bone and good feet, would have preferred a lower tail carriage to be critical but overall I was very impressed with his fitness and muscle tone, moved very well, RDCC.

Open Dog (2,0)

1st Tait's Sh Ch Talintyre Winter Shadow. Upstanding dog who stood over a lot of ground, lovely head, round eyes and square muzzle, good neck and shoulders, short coupled and well off for bone with good feet, moved out well making use of the big ring, he was very well presented but again would have preferred a lower tail carriage, felt his good points far outweighed this, DCC & BOS.

2nd Catton/Cook's Daithi Shadow Dog with Ferngate (imp POL). Another nice dog with a striking outline, preferred head of winner but a good neck into good layback of shoulder, level top-line and correct tail set, straight off his back, well off for bone and correct turn of stifle, not the movement or presentation of one but a nice dog.

Post Graduate Bitch (2,0)

1st Skene's Rubethan Cake It or Leave It. Nice enough young bitch with a lot of maturing to do, not the head I was looking for and very fine all through, she was well handled and moved out well.

2nd O'Neill's Mavoureen Shadow Dog. Not really what I was looking for in a R/W setter would benefit from ring-craft.

Open Bitch (4,1)

1st Gardner's Sh Ch Charnborough Charisma of Danwish JW. My notes say absolutely beautiful, loved her last time I judged her as a junior and saw no reason to change my mind, has matured into a most lovely example of our breed with a beautiful head, dark round eyes and square muzzle, long lean neck into sloping shoulders, plenty of chest and depth all through, correct top-line and tail set, correctly carried on the move, well off for bone and moved out very well, beautifully presented, BCC & BOB and so pleased to see her go Gundog Group 2 in a strong group, well done.

2nd Tait's Sh Ch. Talintyre Winter Spice. Another lovely bitch with lots to like, very pretty head and eye, good neck, shoulders and top-line, well off for bone and moved well, lovely colour.

3rd Allen's Ir Sh Ch. Talintyre Winter Starlight at Killora An Ch 22 Cen W.

Veteran Bitch (1,0)

1st Tait's Sh Ch. Lovenjoel Sleeping Beauty. A favourite of mine who gets better with age, love her head and expression, very good on the move but perhaps a shade wide in front, strong quarters used to advantage, presented to perfection as were all dogs from this kennel, RBCC & BV.
