Puppy Dog (1)

1ST Coolfin Whiskey in The Jar (Miss J E Mackay). Well made puppy with good overall balance. Masculine head. Excellent layback of shoulder and return of upper arm. Deep enough in chest for his age. Well ribbed back. Nicely made hindquarters with good width of second thigh. Moved steadily once settled.

Yearling Dog (2)

1ST Roanjora Cremant De Savoie avec Eusanit JW (Miss R & Miss S & Mrs T McDonald & Westwood & Westwood). Very smart dog whom I have no doubt has a bright future ahead of him. Excellent overall balance. Super head. Good length of neck into well laid shoulders and return of upper arm. Good depth and width of chest. Well ribbed back. Powerful hindquarters and well let down hocks. His movement is a joy to watch. Considered for higher honours.

2ND Settersay Dragonstone (Mr D Sayer). Currently at the "in between" stage. Good overall balance. Pleasing head and expression. Well laid back shoulder and good forelegs. Needs to strengthen through body and hindquarters. Moved steadily.

Post Graduate Dog (1)

1ST Hodgehall Don't Stop Me Now with Rogansrock (Mrs E Holgate). Very well balanced all through. Nicely shaped head with kind expression. Strong neck leading to good lay of shoulder. Well ribbed back. Little straight in stifle. Good bone and feet. Moved

on a good stride.

Open Dog (3)

1ST Sh Ch Talintyre Winter Shadow (Mrs J Tait). Super dog who was very close to top honours today. Excellent overall balance and well constructed all through. Head of correct proportions with strong muzzle. Clean neck leading to well laid shoulders. Good depth of chest and spring of rib. Powerful, well muscled hindquarters. Excellent bone and feet. Moved on a good length of stride. RCC.

2ND Laoirebay Monte Carlo (Mr M I & Mrs W E Taylor). Another dog who is well balance and with good overall construction. Correctly shaped head with slightly domed skull. I would like a little more length in neck. Enough depth of chest. Well ribbed back. Strong hindquarters with good definition of second thigh. Moved out well.

3RD Sh Ch Daithi Shadow Dog with Ferngate (Imp Pol) (Mrs A B & Mr S H Catton & Cook)

Veteran Dog (2)

1ST Carrick Shadow Dog at Alanea (Imp Pol) (Mrs A Tattersall). Super dog from every angle. A real stallion male. Excellent overall balance. Head of good proportions with slightly square muzzle and moderately domed skull. Good length of neck leading to well laid shoulder and return of upper arm. His chest has good depth and his ribcage is correctly sprung. Strong hindquarters with good width of second thigh and well placed hocks. Excellent bone and feet. A close call between him and the open winner (who I understand is his son). He just had the edge on movement today. CC and BV

2ND Roanjora Tanqueray (Mr R Mapletoft). Pleasing male with good overall balance. Head well shaped with strong neck. Deep in chest and well sprung rib cage. Well made hindquarters. Not the movement of the winner.

Special Beginners Dog (1)

1ST Coolfin Whiskey in The Jar (Miss J E Mackay). 1st in PD. Best Special Beginners.

Puppy Bitch

1ST Coolfin Baltic Tum The Page (Miss P Jakins). Litter sister to the PD and just a little more forward in her development at this stage. Very well balanced all through. Correct head proportions. Clean neck leading to good lay of shoulder and corresponding length of upper arm. Deep in chest and well ribbed back. Very well made hindquarters and well placed hocks. Moved out with confidence on a good stride. BP.

Yearling Bitch (2)

1ST Roanjora Crémant D'alsace JW (Mr R G, Mrs A D & Miss R McDonald). Super young bitch whose title must be just around the corner. Excellent overall balance. Scores in head and forehead construction. Deep enough in chest and well ribbed back. Strong well made hindquarters with excellent bone and feet. Moved out well with drive. In contention for top honours – just not quite the finish in coat as the older bitches.

2ND Settersay Tully (Mr D Sayer). Good overall balance. Still very raw at the moment. Pleasing head. Enough depth of chest. Little weak in neck. Well laid shoulder and return of upper arm. Scores in hindquarters. Good bone and feet. Moved steadily.

Post Graduate Bitch (1)

1ST 5531 - Settersay Targaryen Lowdon (Miss V Jarvis). Very well made bitch who just needs time to realise her full potential. Well shaped head with slightly domed skull. Clean, muscular neck leading to well laid shoulders and return of upper arm. I would like a little more depth of chest. Well ribbed back. Well made hindquarters with good width of second thigh. Good bone and feet. Moved out on a good stride.

Limit Bitch (1)

1ST Settersay Martell by Corranroo (Mr G C & Mrs J Bayne). Well balanced all

through. Good head shape with slightly domed skull. Neck is muscular and of good length. Well laid shoulders. Would like a little more length in upper arm. Chest of good depth and well sprung rib cage. Strong hindquarters with well placed hocks. Excellent bone and feet. Moved out well.

Open Bitch (3)

1ST Sh Ch Talintyre Winter Spice (Mrs J Tait). A truly lovely bitch. Excellent overall balance. Scores in head with a melting expression. Neck is clean and of good length leading to well laid shoulder and corresponding length of upper arm. Chest of good depth. Well ribbed back leading to strong, well muscled hindquarters. Long from hip to hock with good definition of second thigh. Well placed hocks with strong rear pasterns. Excellent bone and feet. Shown in tip top condition. Moved out well on a good length of stride. A close call between her and the veteran winner but she just had the edge. CC and BOB.

2ND Alanea Silhouette (Mrs A Tattersall). Another quality bitch who could change places on another day as there was not much between her and the winner. Excellent overall balance. True head with slightly domed skull and square muzzle. Strong neck leading to well laid shoulder and corresponding return of upper arm. Correct depth of chest and spring of rib. Well made hindquarters with strong hocks. Excellent bone and feet. In excellent coat and condition. Just felt the winner was a little more precise on the out and back. Good length of stride when viewed in profile.

3RD Sh Ch Roanjora Rioja Crianza (Mr R G, Mrs A D & Miss R McDonald)

Veteran Bitch (1)

1ST Sh Ch Lovenjoel Sleeping Beauty (Mrs J Tait). A great favourite of mine whom I have judged before. Hard to believe that she is now 10 years old. A great credit to her owner. Excellent overall balance. True head with soft expression. Clean, slightly arched,
