1st: Martin & Martin & Green: Rhoswendale Game Is On Again For Vizaset (Imp Fin): Very tidy, well boned and athletic boy. Handsome head with correct back skull onto moderate neck sitting smoothly into shoulder line. He is well ribbed back and strong in his loin. Moderately bent stifles on hindquarters of good width. Moved well on the around showing some reach and drive. RDCC

OD (1)

1st: Tattersall: Carrick Shadow Dog At Alanea (Imp Pol): Really pleasing for type with a good eye shape and colour, low set ears and good shape to skull without any prominent occiput. Well laid shoulder and return of upper arm. Deep ribbing carried well back to a strong loin. Wide hindquarters and moderate bend to stifles. Stands on good bone and decent feet. Moved precisely with no slackness to rear movement. A really workmanlike boy of quality: DCC & BOB

VD (1)

1st: Taylor: Laoirebay Monte Carlo: Typey dog of good size and shape. Pleasing head and expression. Front assembly could be a little more angulated. Deep, well sprung ribs. Moderate hindquarters with decent bend to stifles. Moved soundly. BVIB

Special Beginners Dog (1)

1st : Jones: Roanjora Cremant Bourgogne: Young boy who possesses a super head and expression with good eye shape and colour, low set ears and good back skull. Still a little immature in his development but all essentials are there. Moved well with great tail action. BSpBIB

PB (2,1)

1st: Jakins: Coolfin Baltic Turn The Page: Youngster of 10 months who is still a wee bit raw all through. She has a pleasant head with correct eye shape, good length to foreface and okay through her skull. Moderate length to neck set cleanly into shoulders. Well ribbed back, enough musculature to her loin and moderate hindquarters. Just a little steep in croup. Stands on good bone and decent feet. Moved soundly and happily. BPIB.

PGB (2)

1st: Bayne: Settersay Martell By Corranroo: What a beautifully balanced, medium sized, girl she is who exudes breed type. Her construction throughout is top class with correct angulation front and rear and good development of forechest and stands straight and true. Her head, for me, is quite special, it is so balanced from foreface with correct finish to muzzle through her stop to correct back skull with no trace of prominent occiput or heavy cheeks. Well-shaped eye and low set ears. Deep, well sprung ribs carried well back to strong loin. Excellent length to her croup and wide well developed hindquarters with moderate bend of stifle mirroring her front angulation. She stands on good bone and feet. On the move out and back she was true and precise on the around she showed lovely reach and drive. A close

decision in the challenge but she just had the edge with her strong topline and precision on the move. BCC

2nd: Jakins: Coolfin Ailbhe: Rangier girl who has a pleasing head with low set on of ears, good length to foreface and well finished back skull. Decent layback to shoulders would just like a better return of upper arm to allow for more reach. Good through her ribbing and strong loin. Wide nicely angulated hindquarters. Move soundly.

LB (1)

1st: Tattersall: Alanea Silhouette: A quality girl of good type in all departments. Good head and expression with well-shaped eye of good colour and low set on of ears, correct finish to back skull. Strong moderate neck set cleanly into well angulated front assembly. Stands on good bone and decent feet. She is deep all through her ribbing, carried well back with good spring. Strong loin and wide, moderately angulated hindquarters, just a little steep in croup. Moved true out and back showing some lovely reach on the around.

OB (2)

1st: Gardner: Sh Ch Charnborough Charisma Of Danwish JW: A top class girl who I have judged before and she is of super breed type. Lovely, balanced head and expression. Correct eye shape and colour, low set ears and good back skull. Clean through her neck into the best of front assemblies with nice amount of forechest and true front. Deep well sprung ribs carried to a strong loin and wide hindquarters moderate bend to stifles would just like a little more length to her croup. Moved, today a little loose through her front when coming toward and not quite holding her topline as I know she can, in profile. She was just pipped to the CC by the eventual winner on just this slight imperfection today, but could not be denied RBCC.

2nd: Allen: Ir Sh Ch Talintyre Winter Starlight At Killora An CH 22 CEN W : Pleasing girl who has good proportions all through. Head is good but not the balance of the winner. She stands on good bone and okay feet Balanced front assembly would just like a little more angulation. Good through her ribbing and moderate hindquarters. Tidy movement.

Good Citizen Dog Scheme Bitch (1)

1st: Skene: Rubethan Cake It Or Leave It Sgwc : Pleasing overall conformation and breed type. Presented in rock hard muscle well-conditioned. Good head proportions and well balanced. Good in front assembly, she stands on good bone and excellent feet. Good spring to ribs which are deep would just like them a little longer. Strong loin and moderate hindquarters just a little steep in croup. Moved true out, back and around. A solid performance.
