



CHAMPIONSHIP SHOWS POINTS COMPETITION

Trophies & Rosettes are awarded at the AGM for this Competition.

Trophies

Club Trophies and Rosettes are awarded for **Best Dog**, **Best Bitch** and **Best Puppy**.

The **Bellavanti Beachcomber Trophy** is awarded to the dog or bitch winning the greatest number of CCs during the year.

The **Working Together Trophy** is awarded annually by the Working Sub-committee to the member who has made the most effort to promote the working ability in IRWS's during the past year.

Crufts Best of Breed Trophy is awarded at Crufts.

Rosettes

Rosettes are presented to **1st to 10th placings** in this competition, plus **Best Brood Bitch**, **Best Stud Dog**, **Top Breeder**, **Best Veteran**, **Best Special Beginner** and **Best Working**.

In addition, all new **Show Champions**, **Junior Warrants**, **Veteran Warrants**, **Show Certificate of Excellence** (replacing Show Certificate of Merit) and **Show Gundog Working Certificate** winners for the year are presented with a special rosette to commemorate their achievement.

Qualifying Shows

- All Championship Shows where CCs are awarded for Irish Red & White Setters.
- Show & Group level placings at Championship Shows where no breed CCs are awarded for Irish Red & White Setters.

Note: Non CC Championship Shows and Open Shows are included in the separate Open Show Points Competition. You can enter both competitions.

The Rules

- Owners must be fully paid up members of the Irish Red & White Setter Club of GB
- Points are accumulated from January 1st to December 31st in any year.
- No points are brought forward from previous years, or carried forward to following years unless declared by the Irish Red & White Setter Club of Great Britain.
- **Puppy** points can only be gained from Puppy Classes. In addition Puppy awards at Breed, Group or Show level can only be claimed when gained from a Puppy class.
- **Veteran** points can only be gained from Veteran Classes. In addition Veteran awards at Breed, Group or Show level can only be claimed when gained from a Veteran class.
- **Best Special Beginner** points can only be gained from Special Beginner Classes or associated awards at Breed, Group or Show level.
- **Best Working** points can only be gained from Special Working, Field Trial or Special Field Trial Classes, or associated awards at Breed, Group or Show level.
- Points will only be gained for Awards that are officially declared by the hosting Society. Eg If you are the only Veteran entered, points can be gained for the class place achieved but if the Society has not declared a Best Veteran in Breed then no extra points can be gained for this award.
- If you enter multiple classes all qualifying results will gain points in the overall points competition, not for Best Puppy/Best Veteran.
- The Competition co-ordinator will declare running totals each month on Facebook, with the final positions at the end of December.

Disclaimer: In the event of a tie or dispute no discussions will be entered into and the decision of The Irish Red & White Setter Club of Great Britain shall be final in all circumstances.
