1. Gardner's Sh. Ch. Alanea Game Reserve with Danwish. Well made dog with a nice head and expression, has good substance and bone with a pleasing tail set. Moved very well. Pleased to award him the Res. C.C.
2. Tattersall's Sh. Ch Carrick Shadow Dog at Alanea. Love this dogs head and expression, he is overall a smaller dog than winner, but was well bodied, just not the front angulation of winner. Moved OK.
3. Jakins Sh. Ch. Int. Sh. Ch. Multi Sh. Ch. Terme Des Coris Qaliero at Coolfin JW.

YD (2)

1. Smith's Gilliegrae Berry Good Vibes. Gorgeous head and expression with straight front and pleasing angles. Good bone and reasonable feet. Moved better than his brother.
2. Harts Gilliegrae So Berry Excited. Pleasing head, well bodied but not so together on the move, will be interesting to see the two in a year or so's time.

PGD (1)

1. Holgate's Hodgehall Don't Stop Me Now with Rogansrock. Stood alone but he has a lovely head and expression, well bodied with fair angulation, just needs to make up behind but moved very accurately.

LD (2:1)

1. Catton, Cook & Jakins Coolfin Clancy with Ferngate. Really super dog with the best bone and feet in this entry. Super head, excellent body and angulation but so spoilt himself on the move by pacing. He could have easily been my ticket winner had he performed.

- OD (3)
1. Catton & Cook's Sh. Ch. Daithi Shadow Dog with Ferngate. This dog has so improved with age, his head has improved and has filled out to become the finished article. He has a good layback of shoulder and strong hindquarters with sound movement. C.C.
  2. Titterton's Sh. Ch. Spyefire Reyt Bobby Dazzler. 8 years old with very sound movement, excellent front but not the body of 1.

1. Sayer's Settersay Dragonstone. 2 year old with pleasing head, a little out at elbow at present but needs to body up to complete the picture. Loved his strong hindquarters.

Sp.WD/B (1)

1. Sherrat & Blackwell Sherrat's Ch. Alanea Holly Fern at Chamborough SGWC Feminine head with super front and lay back of shoulder with good length of upper arm. Well bodied with well turned stifles. Moved accurately but a little unsteady behind at times.

1. Ch. A. Holly Fern at C.

PB (1)

1. Eylmann-Von Borstel & Timmermann's Gorgeous 6 month pup. Very nicely put together with an excellent body for age. Moved very well once settled.

YB (2)

1. Jakins Coolfin Baltic Turn the O' Kelly & Hancock's Coolfin The Ecstasy of Gold at Caradilis. Litter sisters with similar heads, 1 is more compact with lovely straight front and level topline. Both moved well but at present 2 spoils her topline when stacked.

LB (2)

1. Bayne's Settersay Martell by Corranroo. CC and BOB. I loved this bitch, she is so well made

with excellent front, topline and quarters, super colour and moved well. Sure she will soon get her 3rd.

2. Tattersall's Alanea Savannah Compact bitch with not quite the angulation of winner but has a sweet head and is a sound accurate mover.

OB (2)

1. Gardner's Sh. Ch. Chamborough Charisma of Danwish. A beautiful bitch who was rather tense today. She has a lovely outline with good angulation and is well bodied. Moved OK but seen her move better. Could not deny her the Res. CC.
